creating key assessments that align with the standards; and using candidate performance data to improve programs. It will be helpful for those who are preparing to submit self-study reports, meeting interim reporting requirements, or responding to conditions.

Teaching Beyond the Screen Time Debates: Rethinking Digital and Media Literacy for Early Childhood

Principle 9 in NAEYC's DAP position statement says, "Effective uses of technology and media by children are active, hands-on, engaging, and empowering." Like traditional literacy, that means it's about curiosity, collaboration, connection, creativity, and choices.
