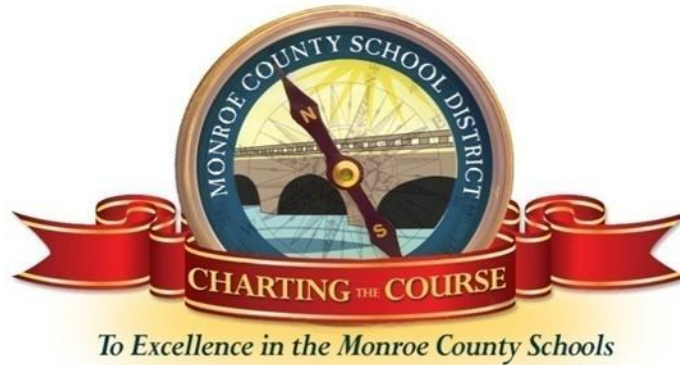

Q&A No.2

1. What will be required of the contractor to permit through the Village of Islamorada for the work done on Founders Park or do we just permit it through our Monroe County School District Building Department? **Answer – please reference Section 1 page 6 of the original bid document.**
2. Can the contractor stage material around the double drive gate in left field? One to two truckloads. This would be prior to haul out. **Answer – Yes, one to two loads may be staged in that area. Staging time not to exceed two weeks. The contractor shall restore the area including seeding grass if appropriate.**
3. May we keep around one truckload of recovered clay in the area between the double drive gate and the bull pen? **Answer – Yes, this is for maintenance work on the field. The new clay material bin at Coral Shores High School may also be used to get rid of extra clay material. Only clay may be added.**
4. Can the contractor stage equipment by the home dugout preferably inside the fence, second choice outside the fence? **Answer – Yes. Remove keys, make safe, and lock vehicle.**
5. Once soccer is over can we lock the gates and close the field while work is being performed? **Answer – Yes, the gates may be locked during this construction period.**
