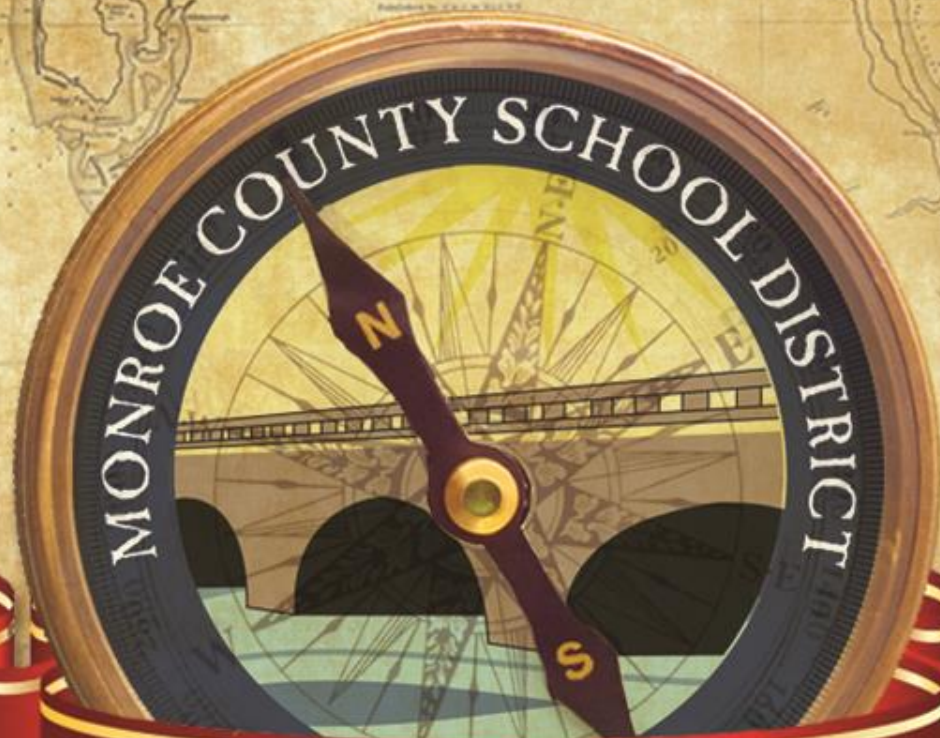

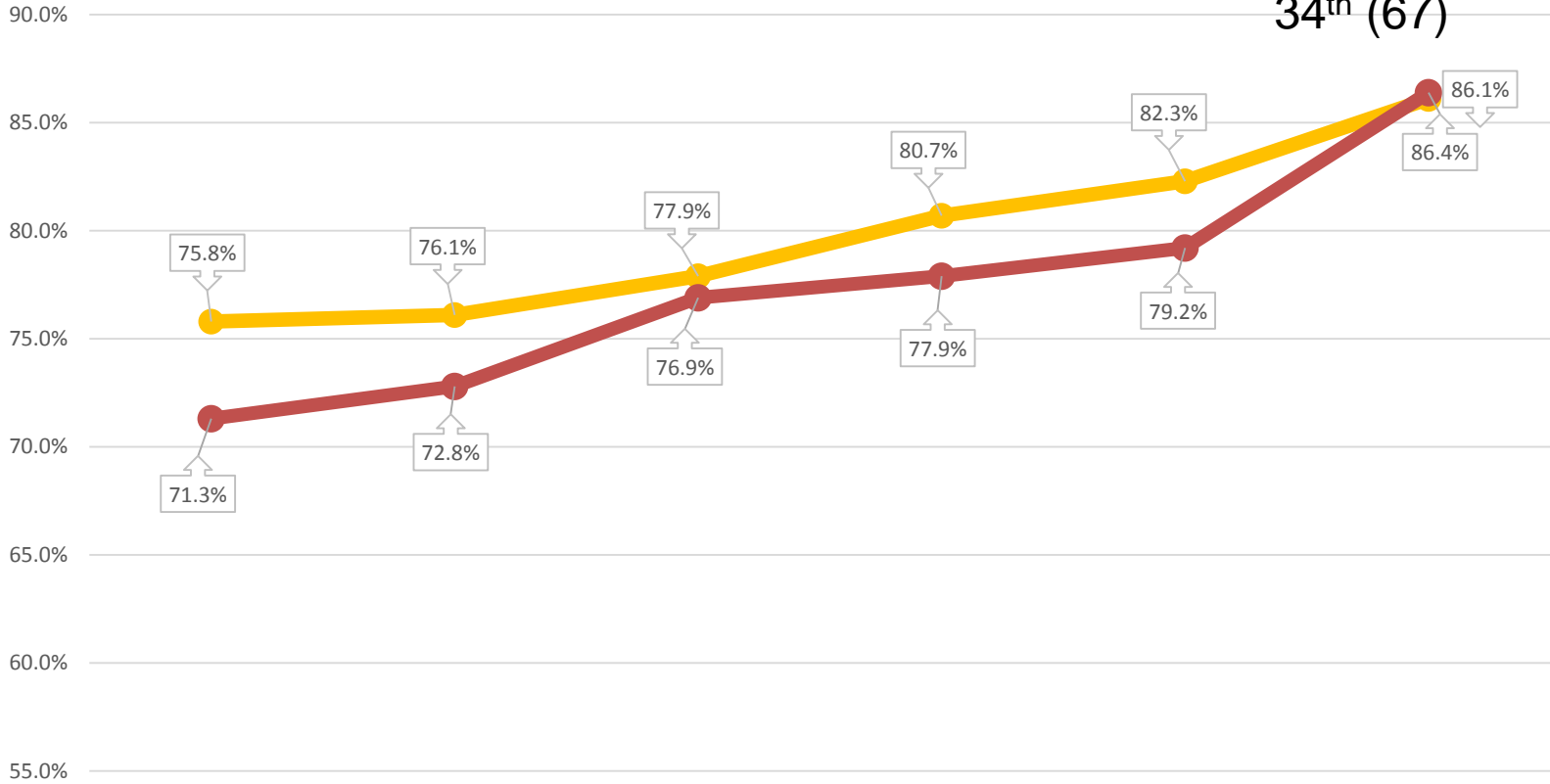
- Strategic Objective 2: Outstanding Student Achievement - The Monroe County Schools will produce globally competitive students and outstanding citizens.

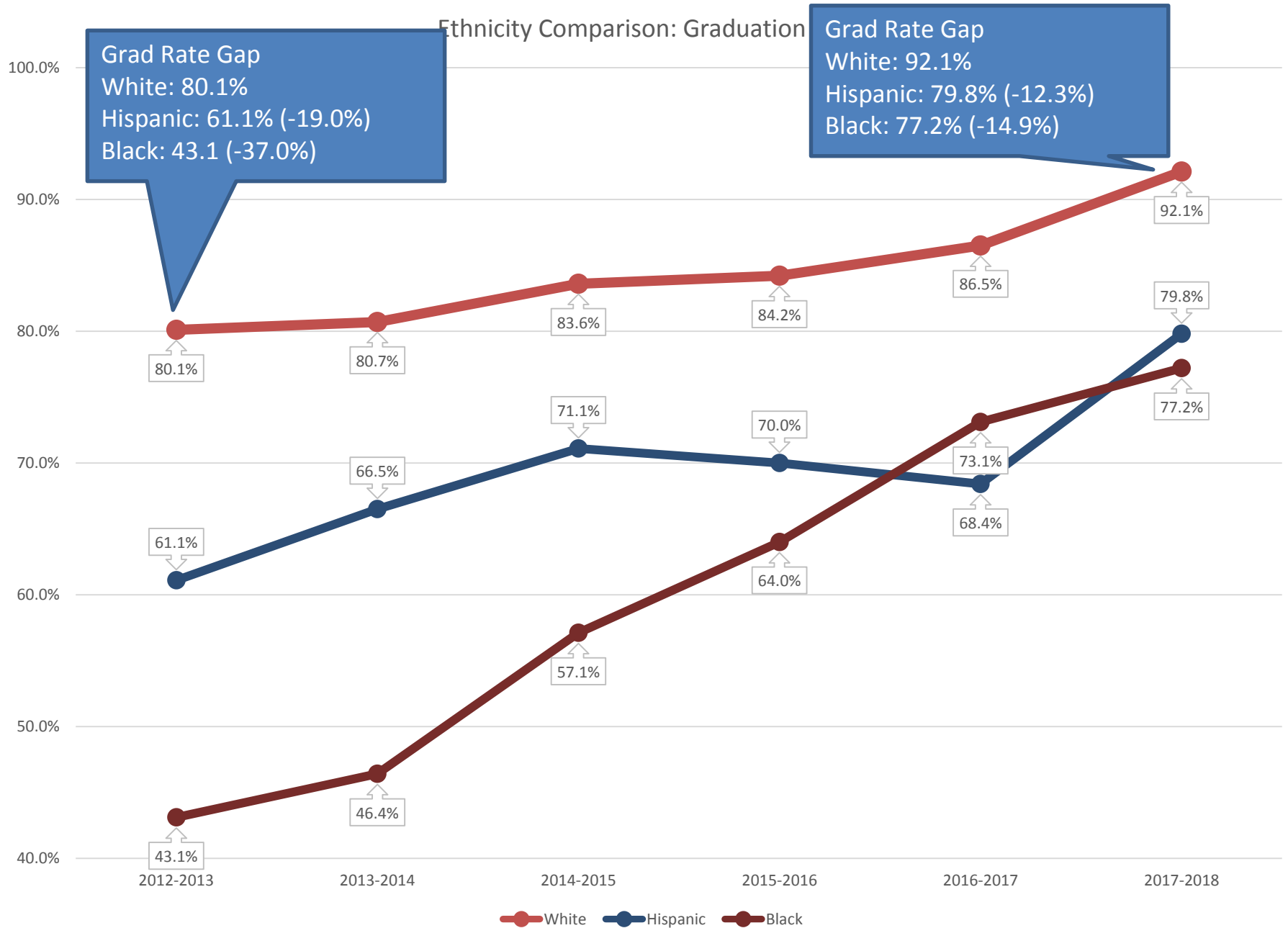

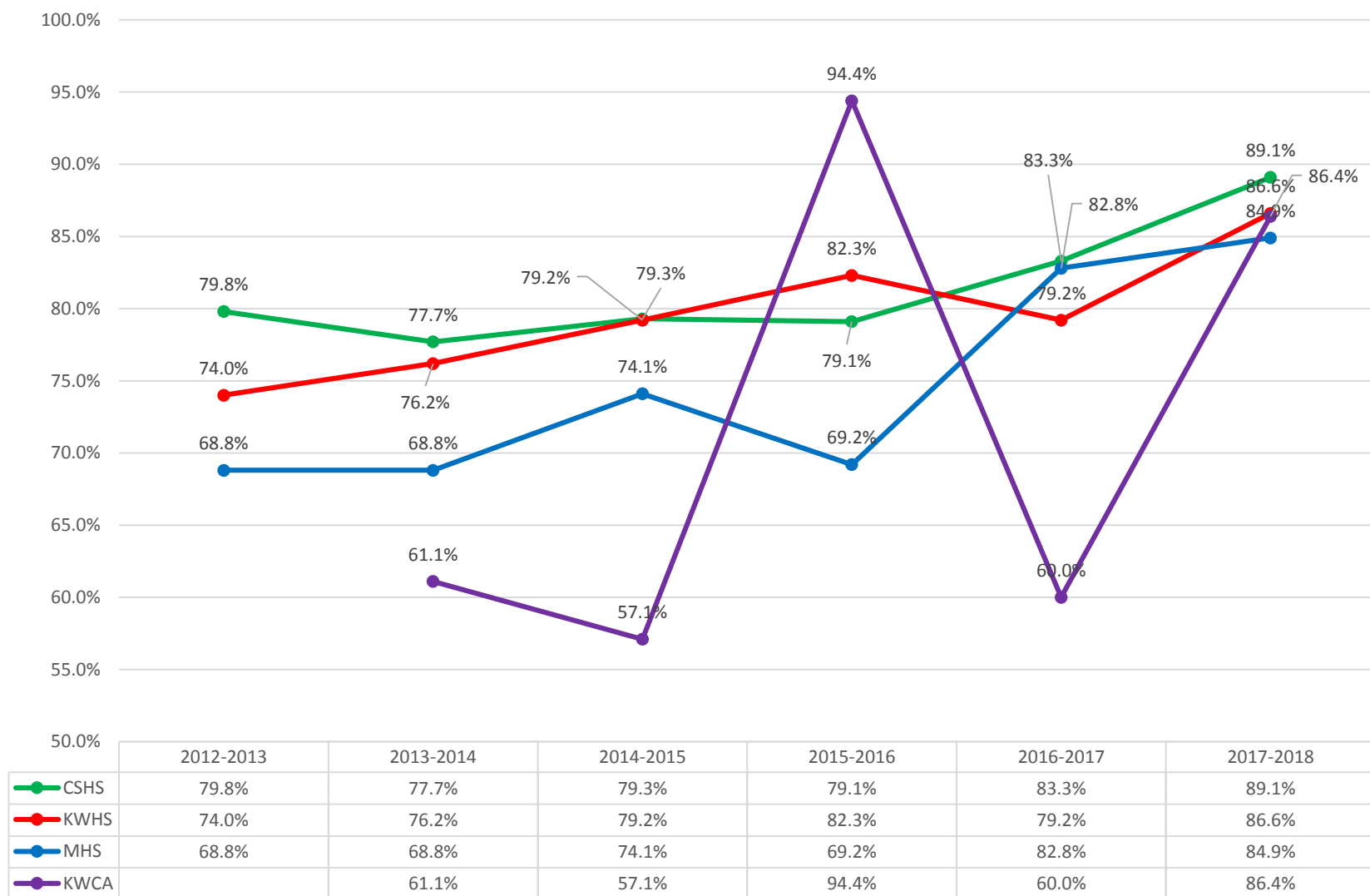

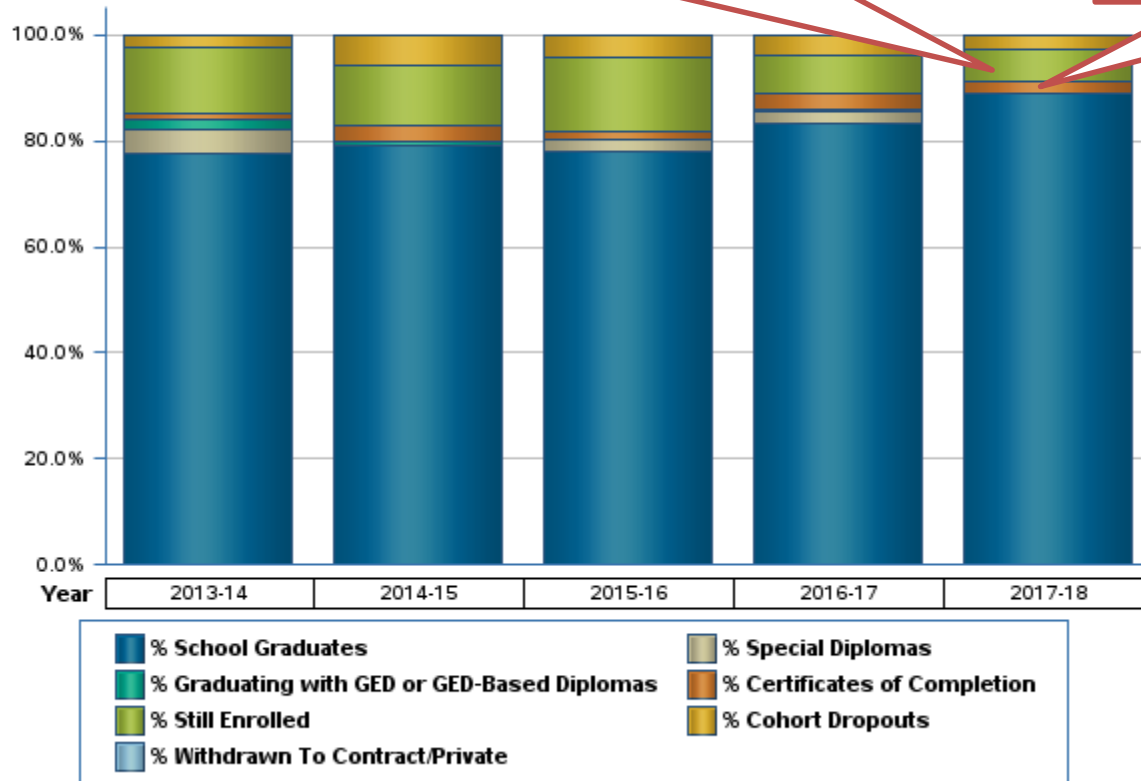

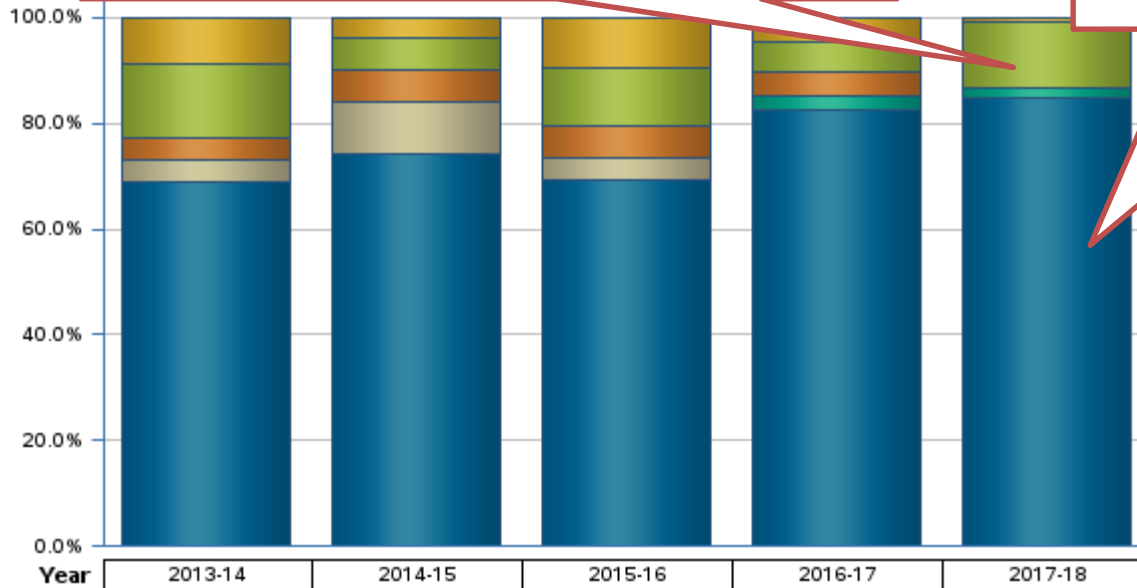

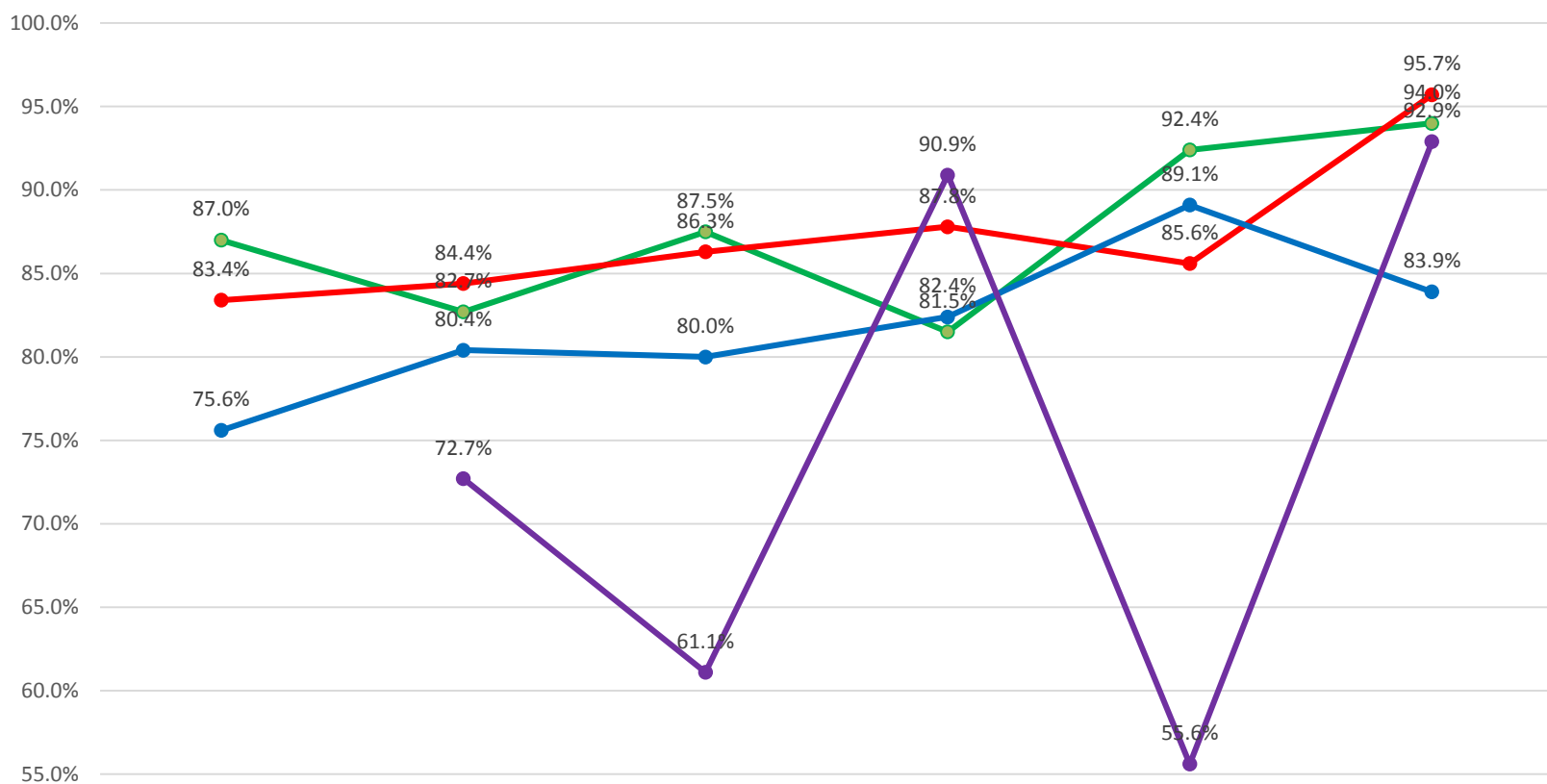

White Students Graduation Rate

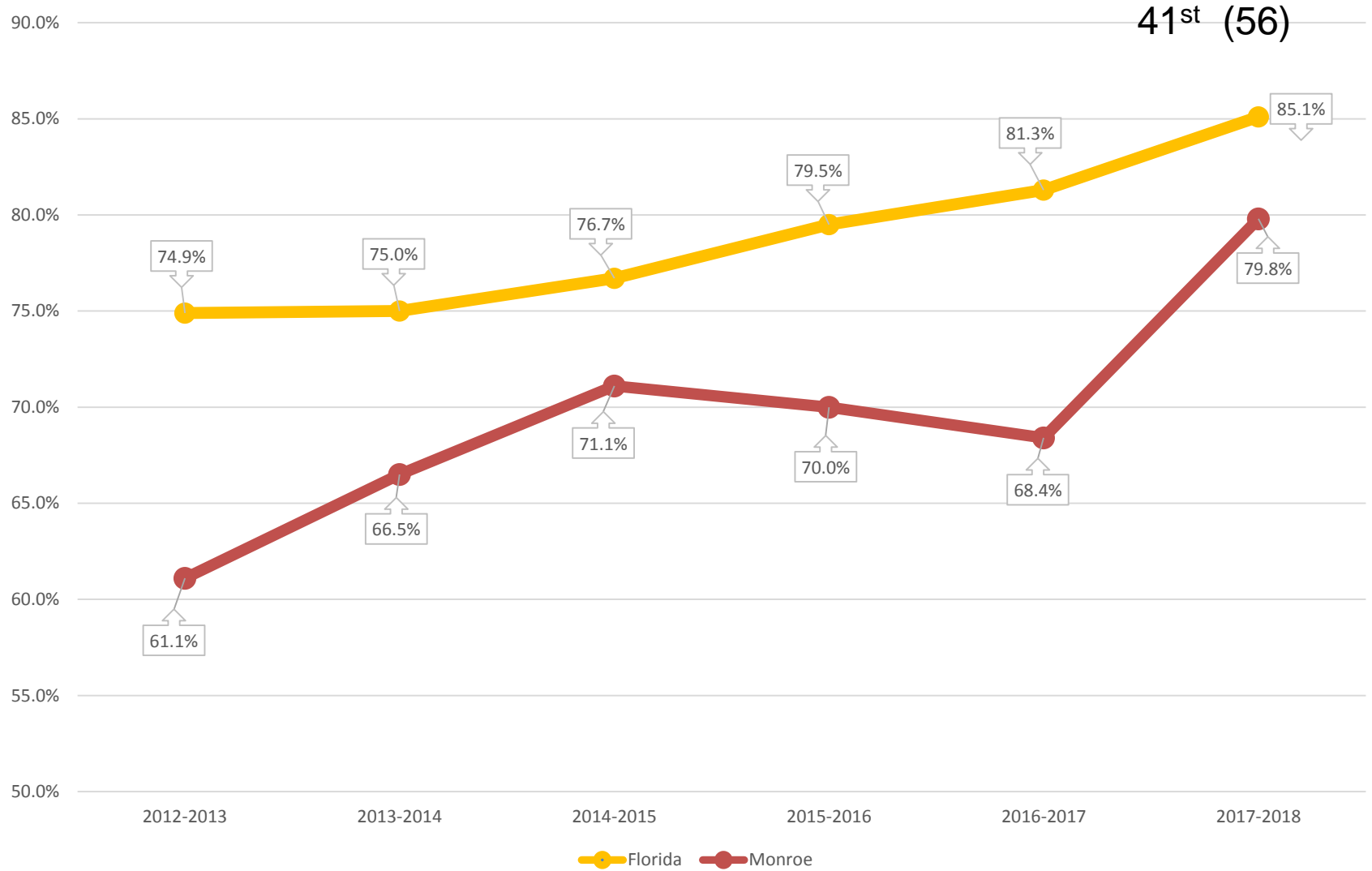

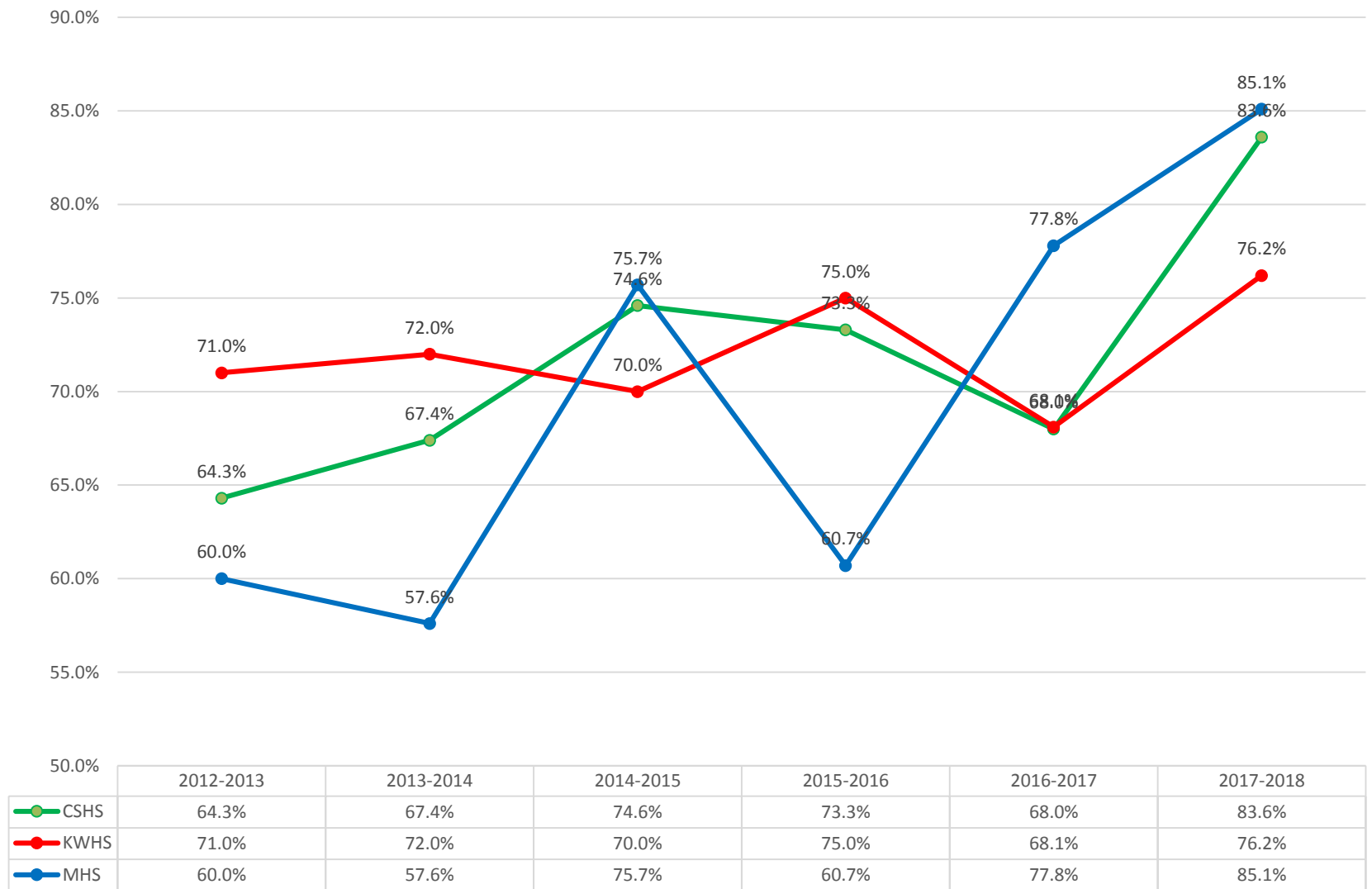

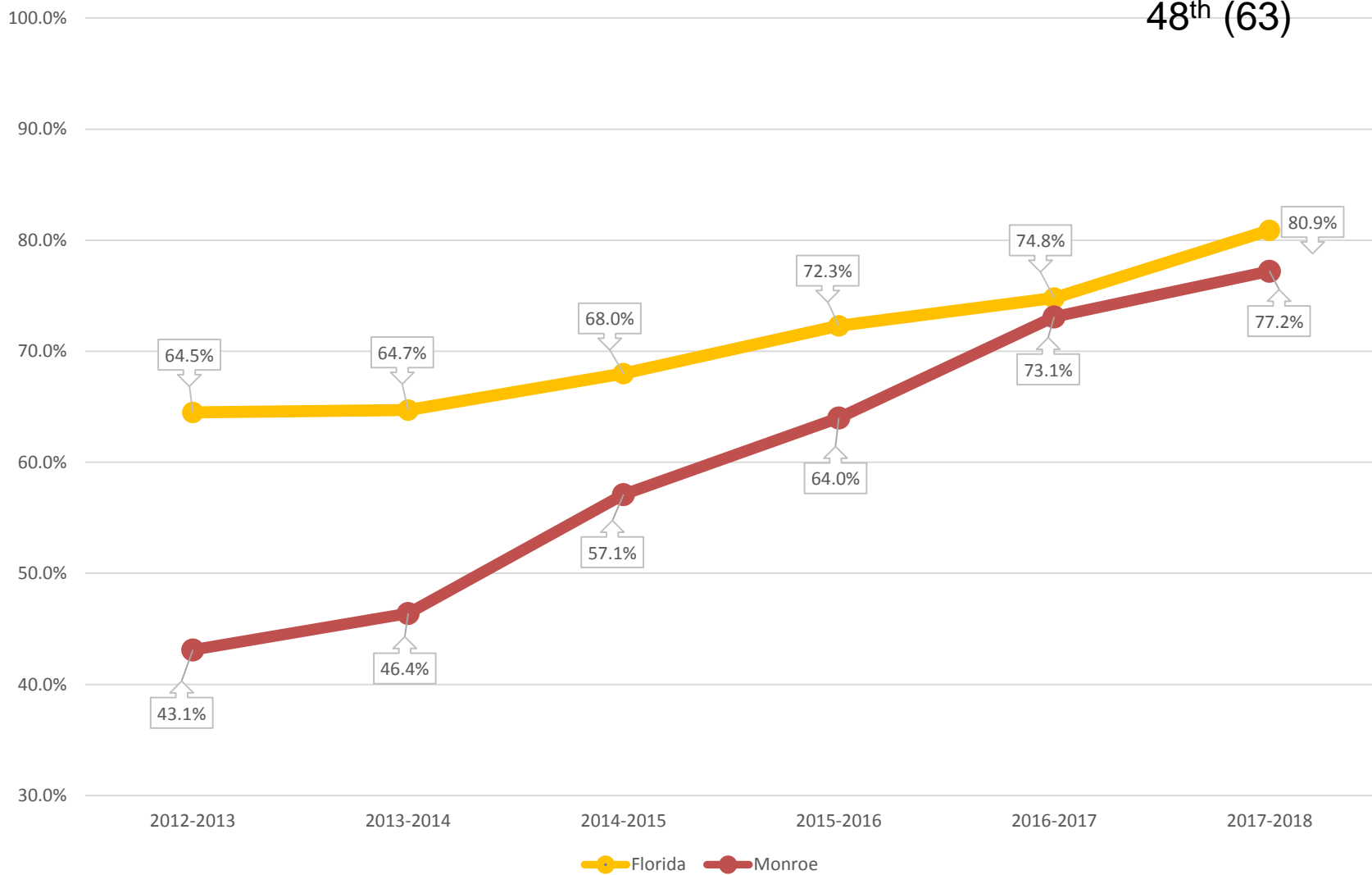


Hispanic Students Graduation Rate

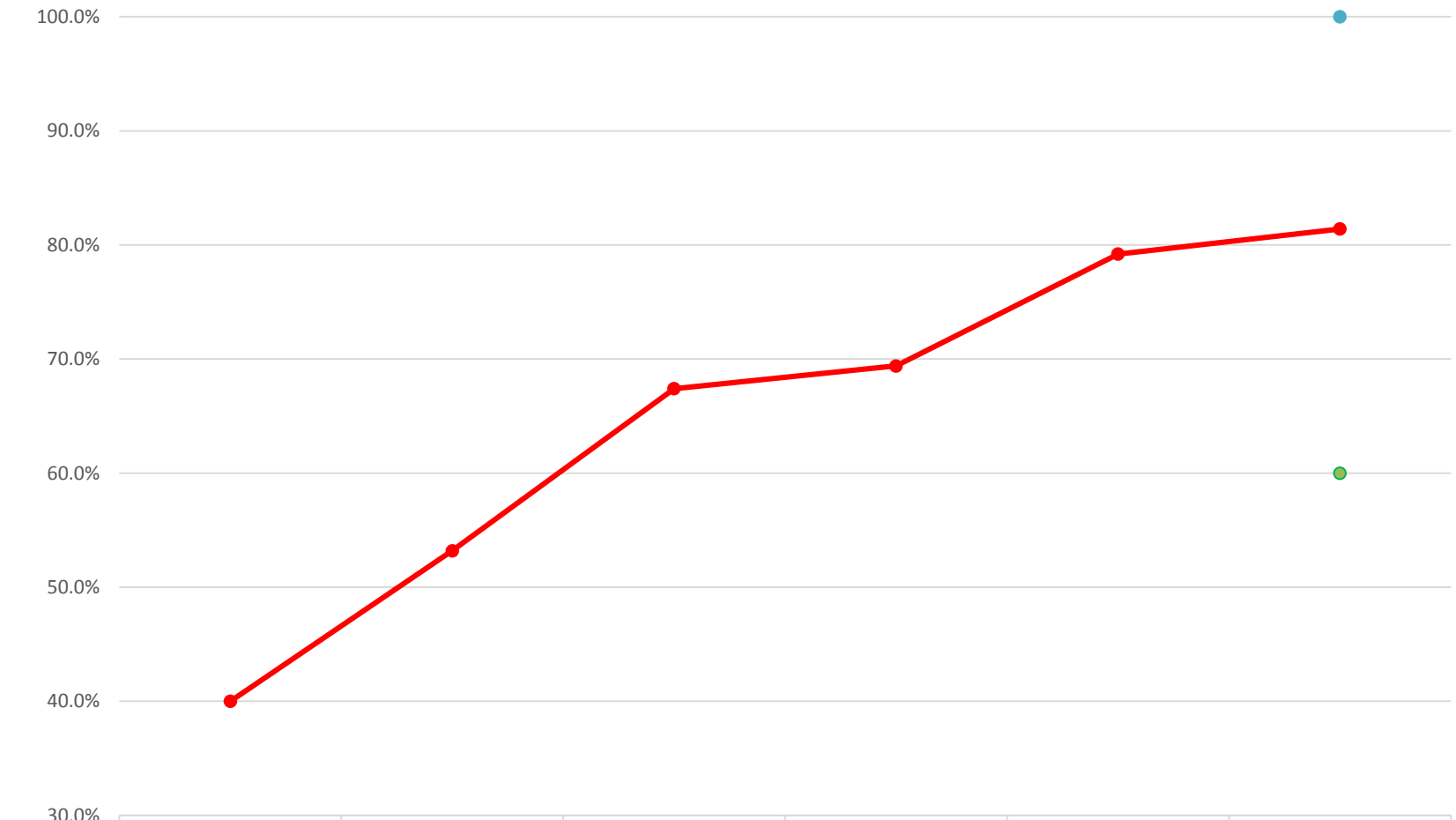


Black Students Graduation Rate

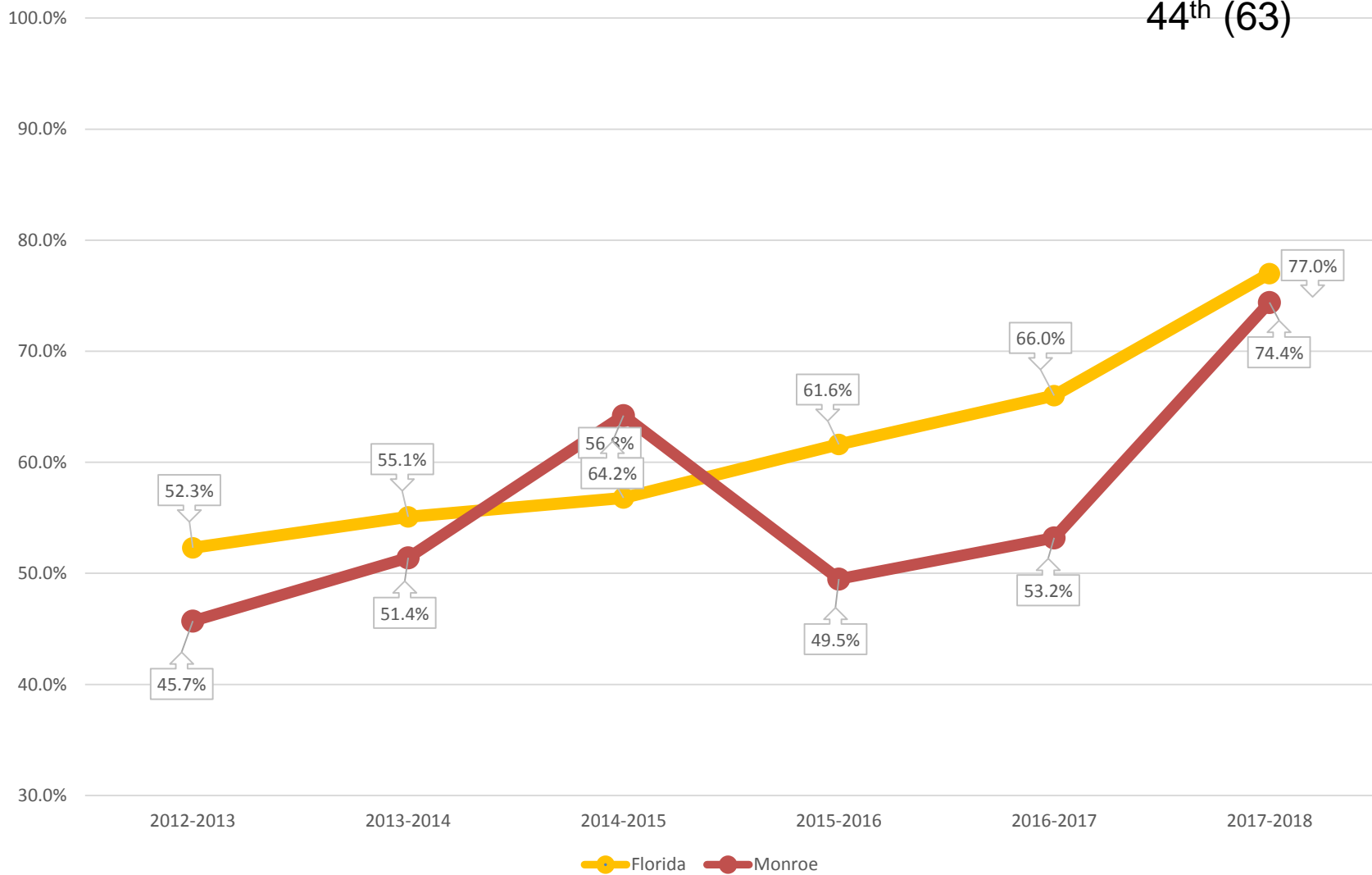

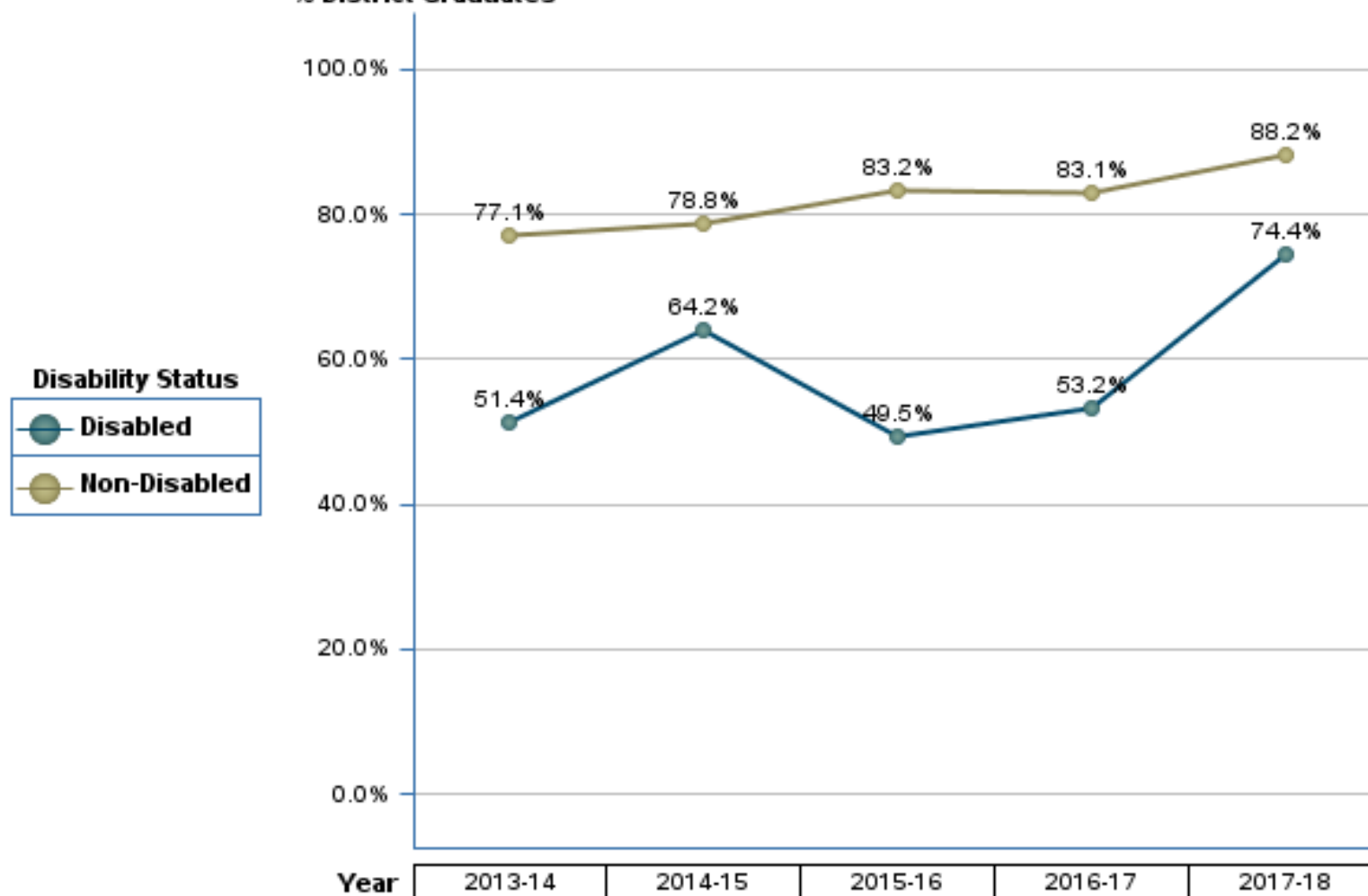

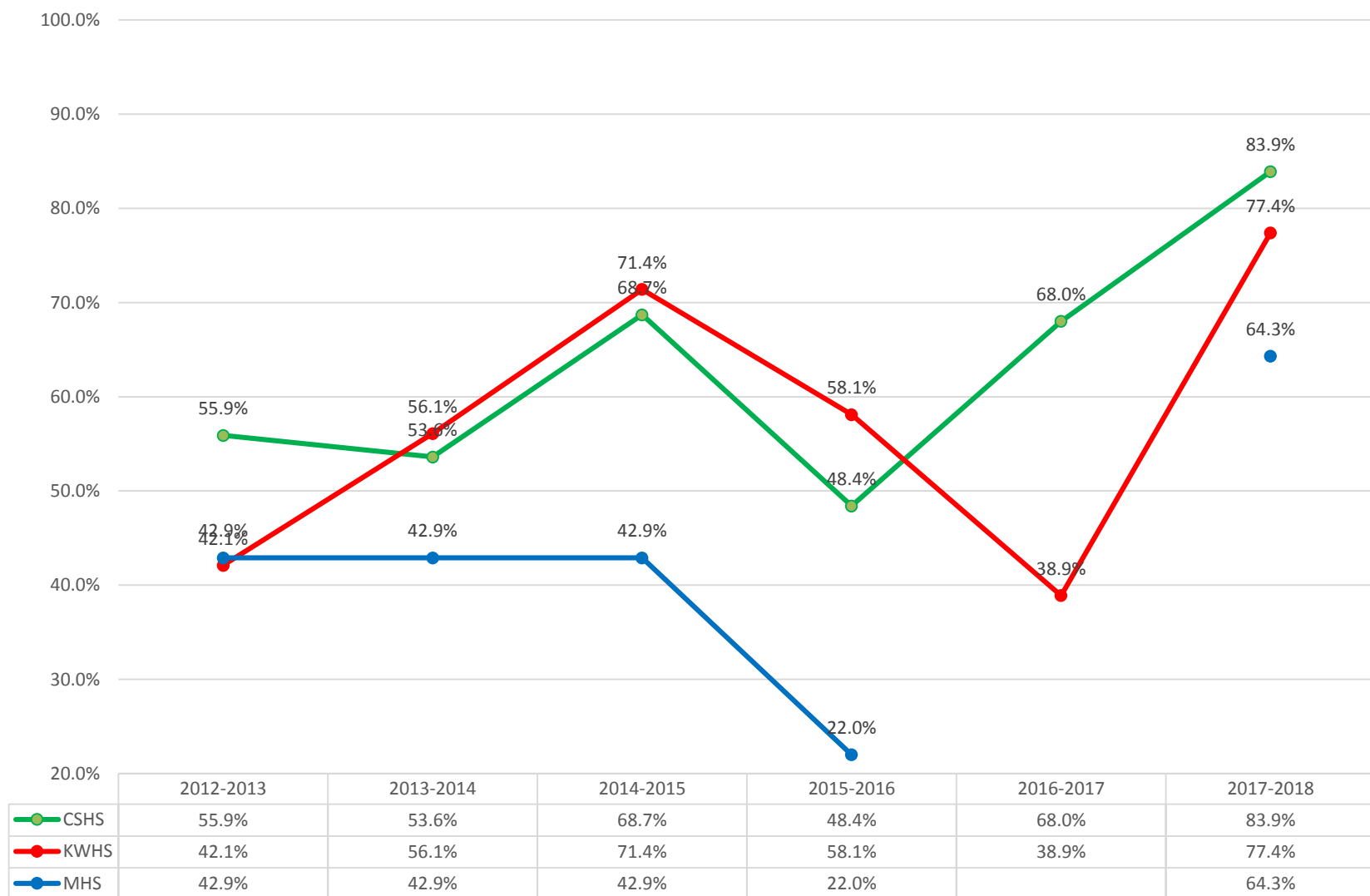
District Graduation Rates by Disability Status

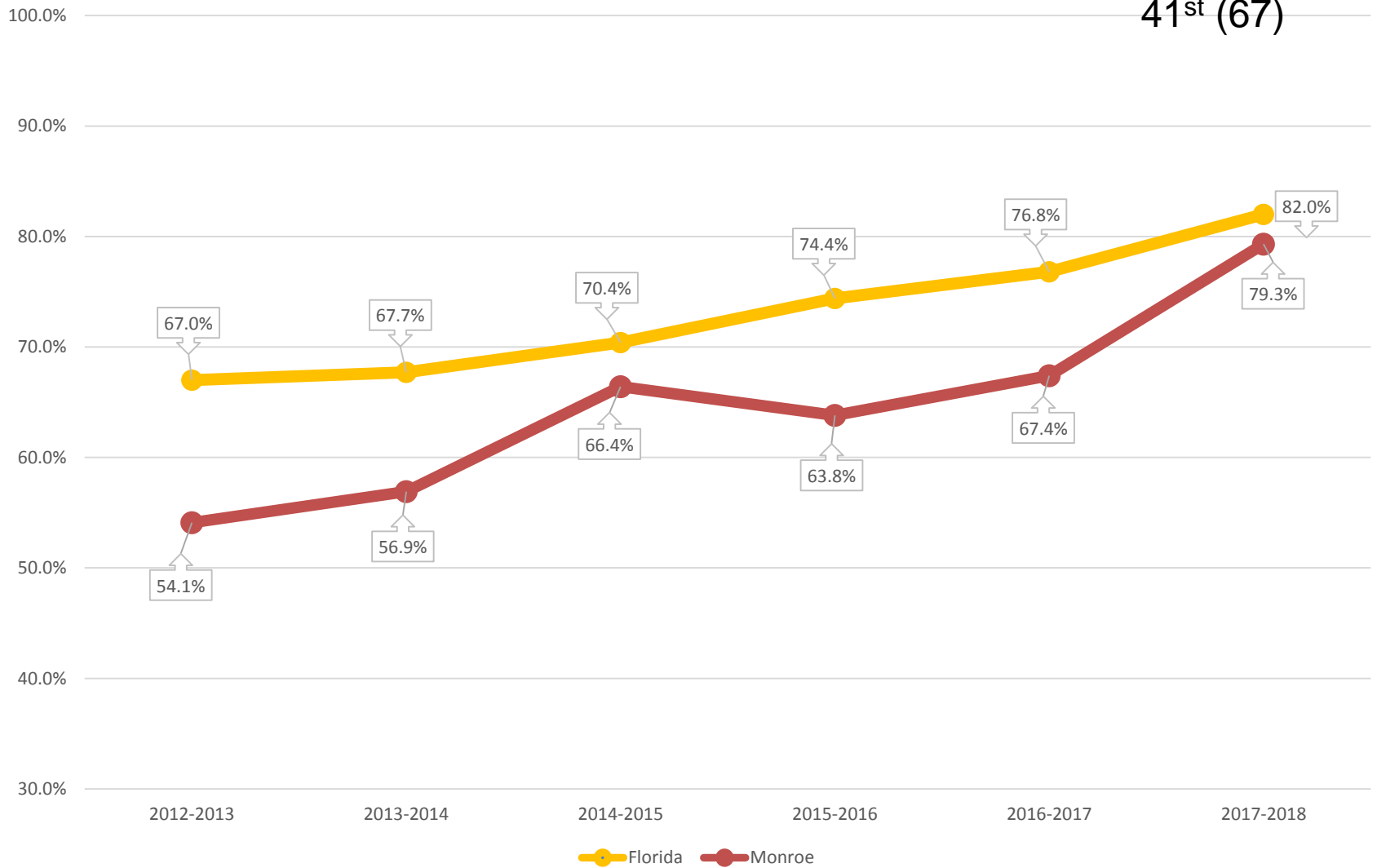


ESE Students Graduation Rate



Low-SES Students Graduation Rate

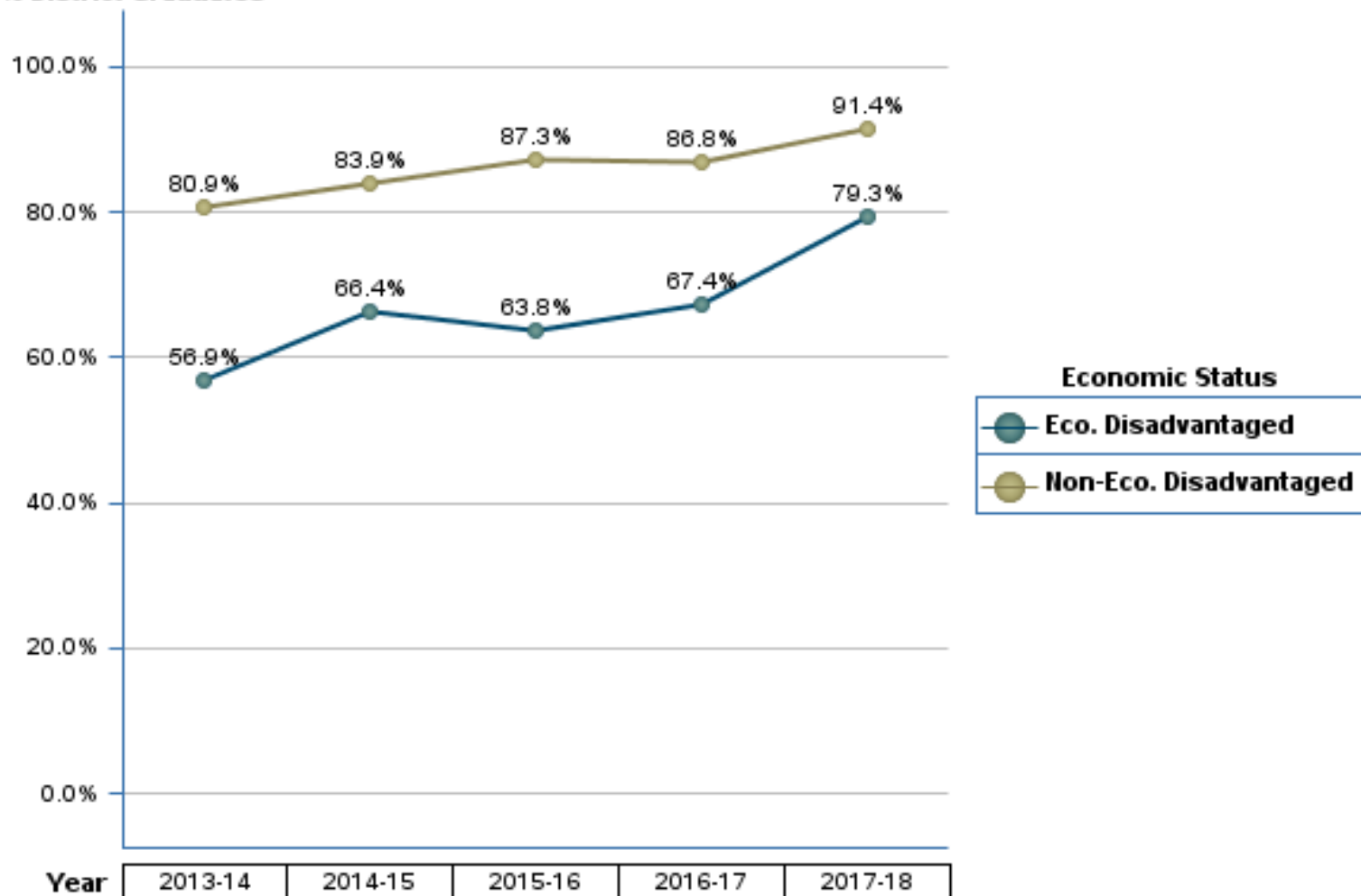

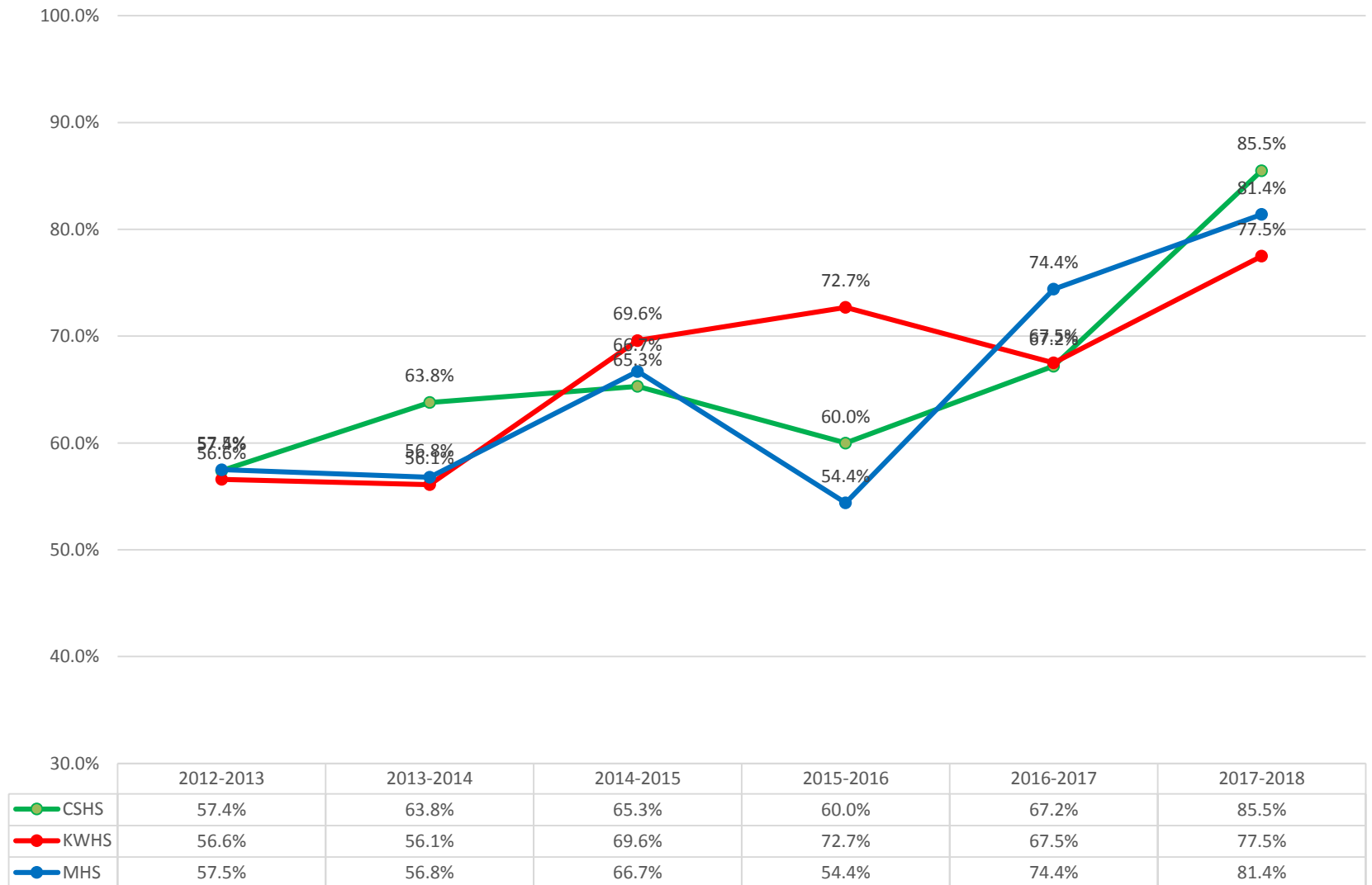
District Graduation Rates by Economic Status

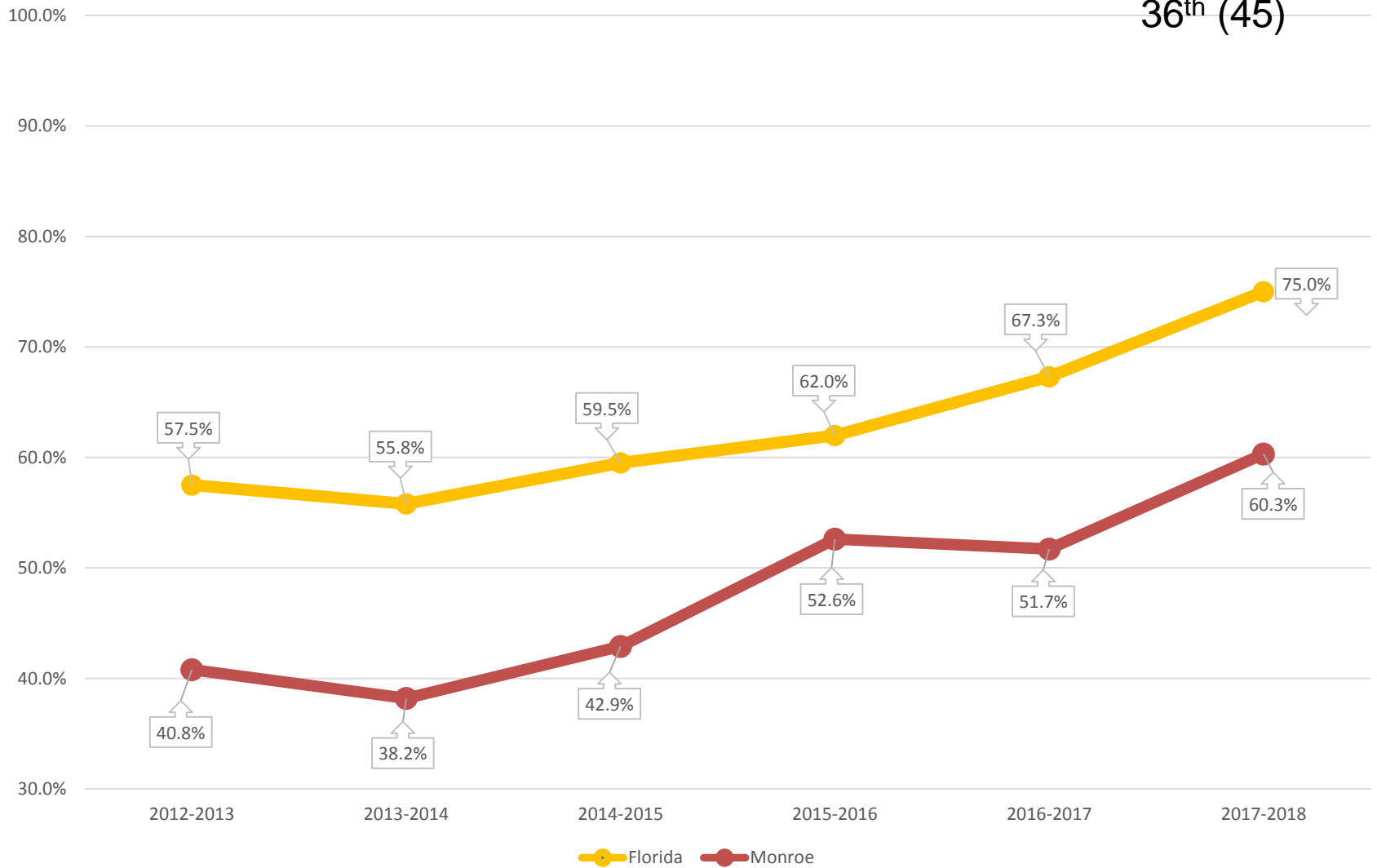


Low-SES Students Graduation Rate



ELL Students Graduation Rate

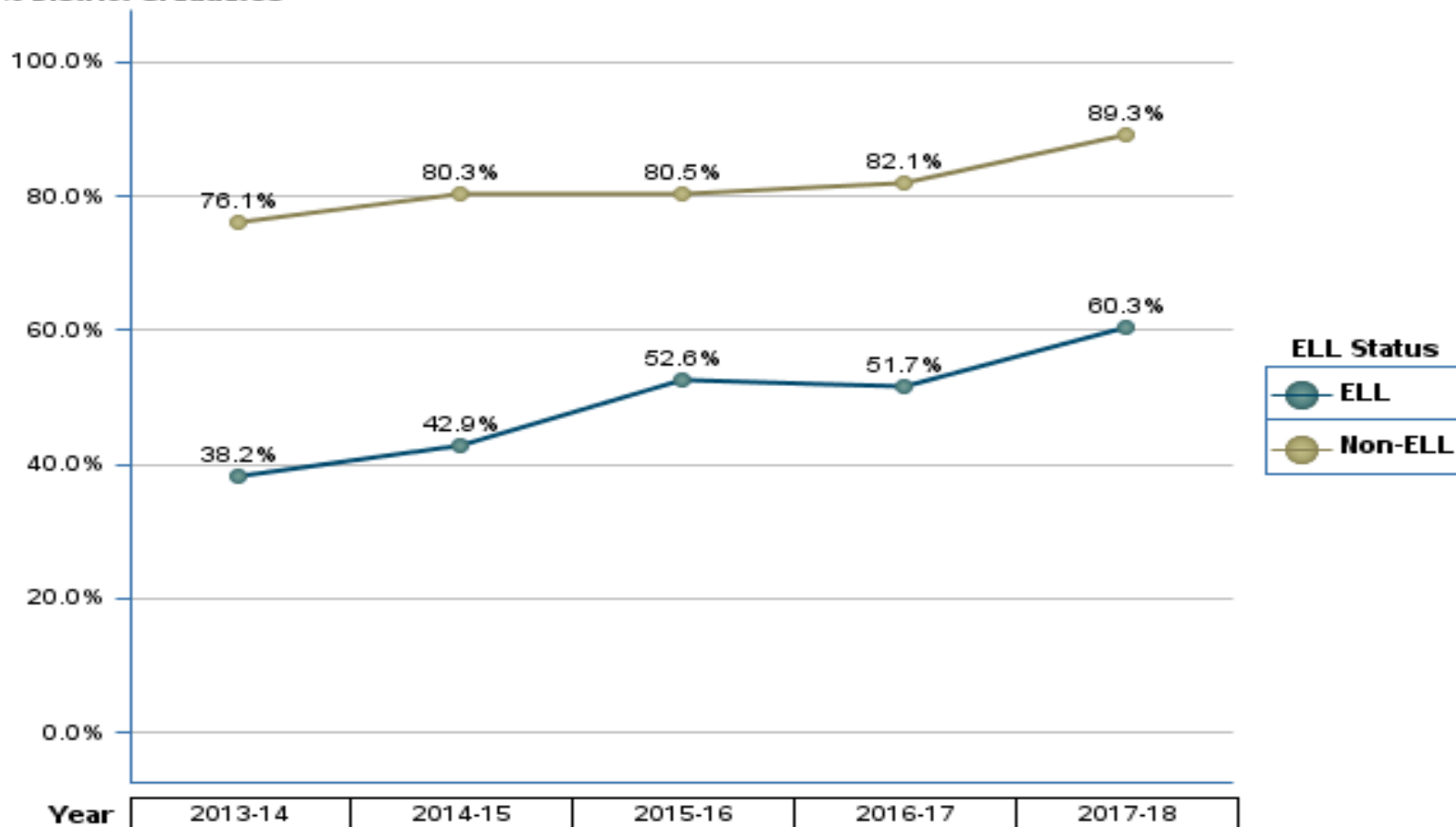

District Graduation Rates by ELL Status

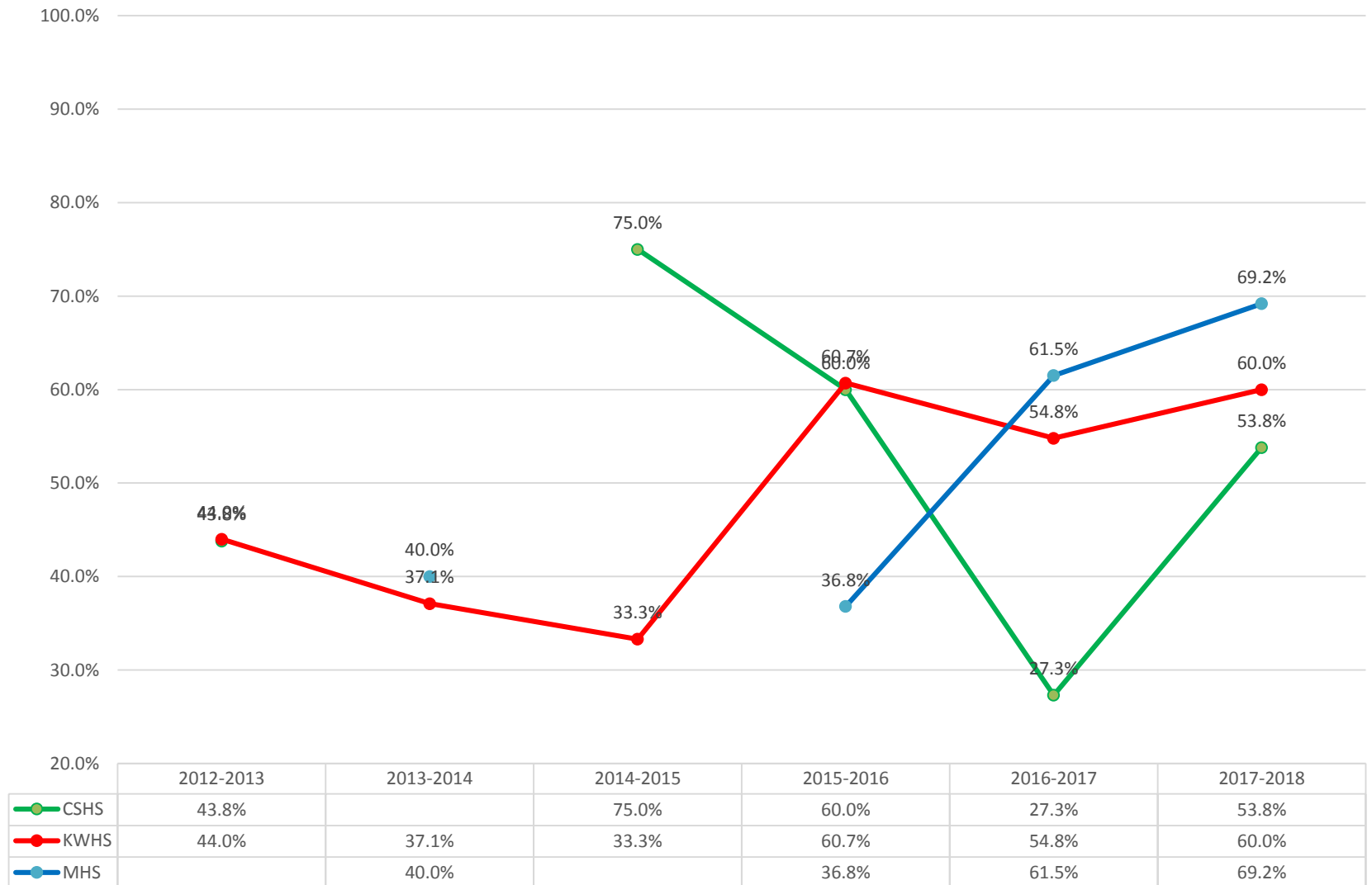

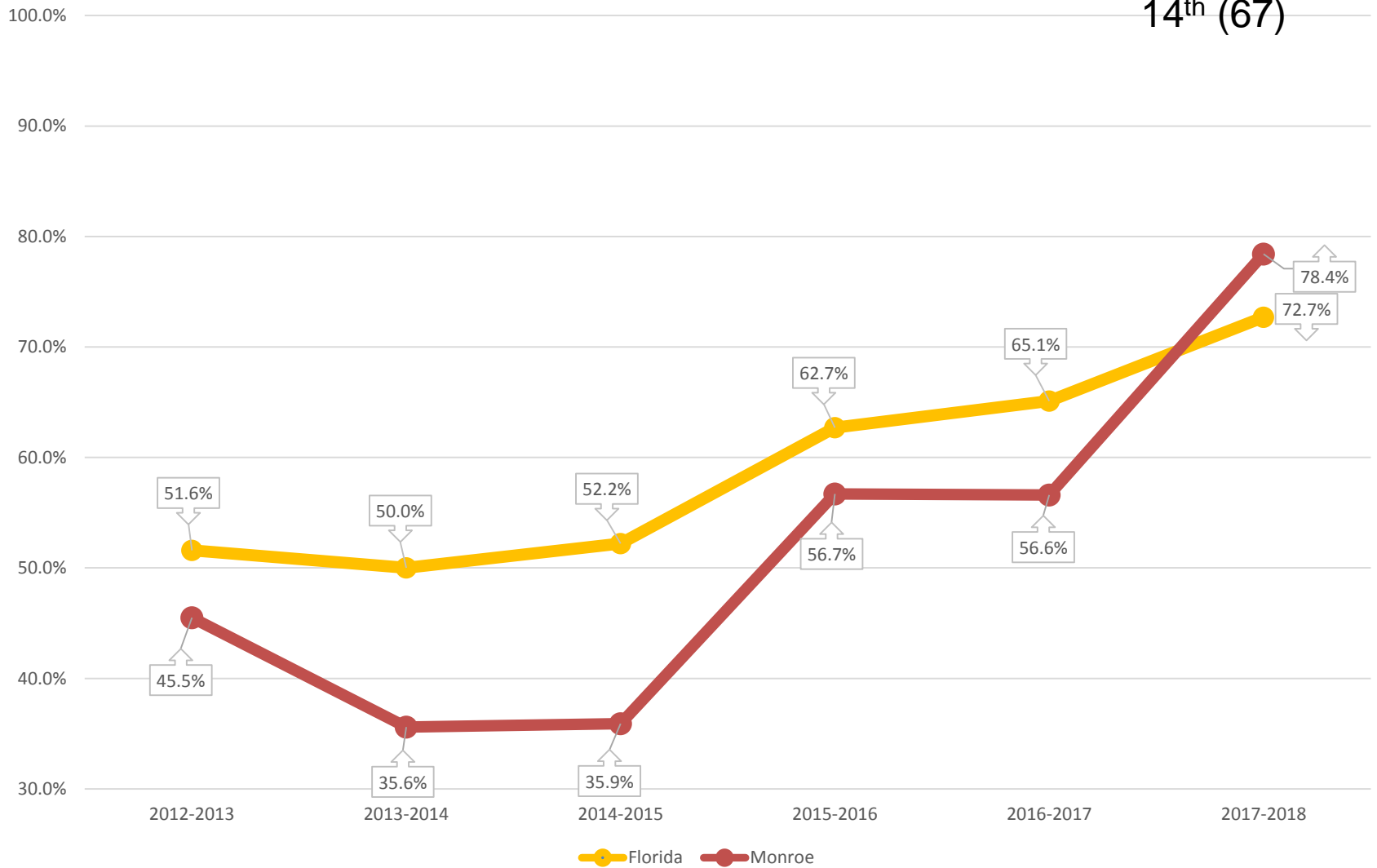
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ELL Students Graduation Rate



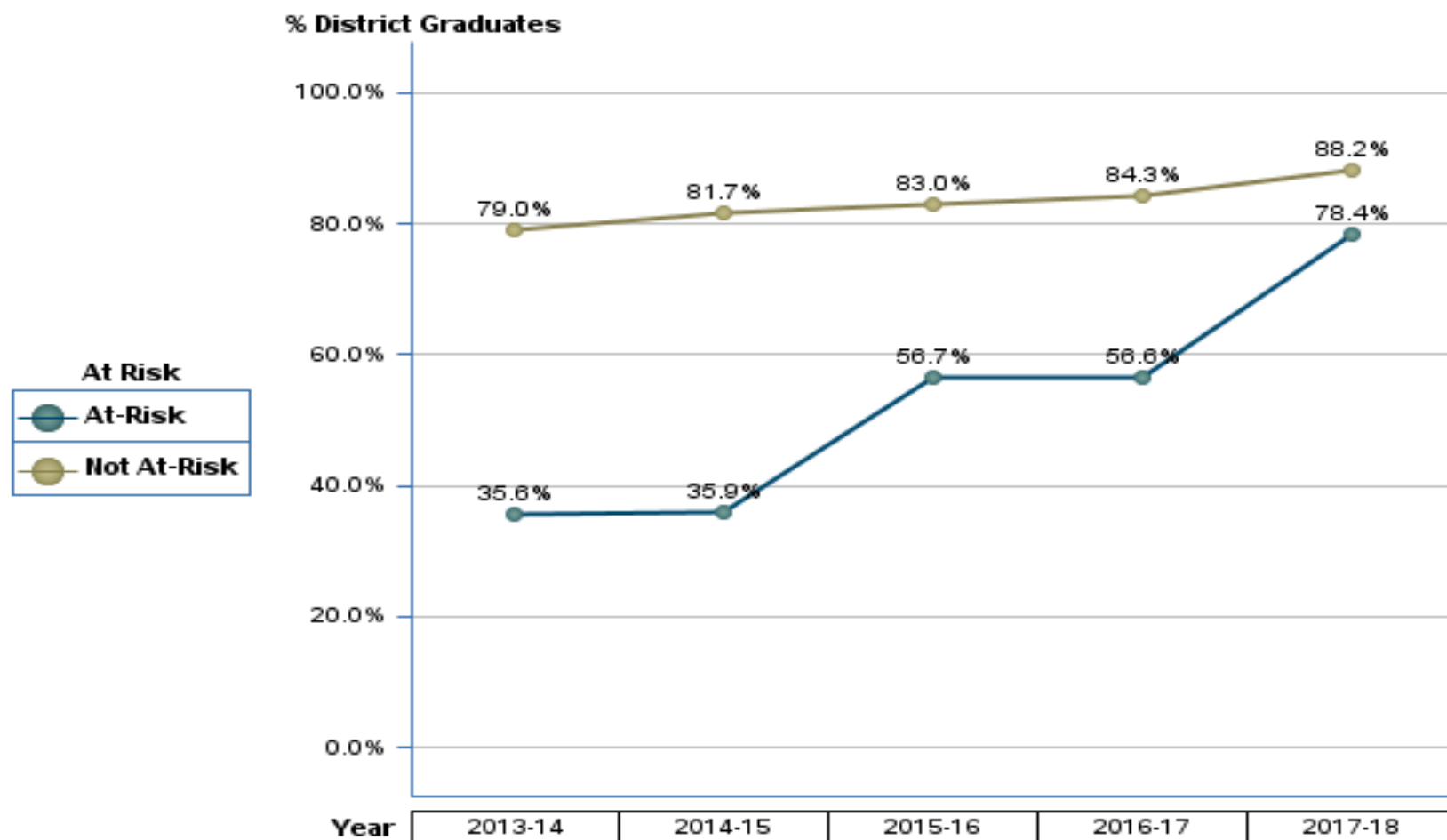
At Risk Students Graduation Rate

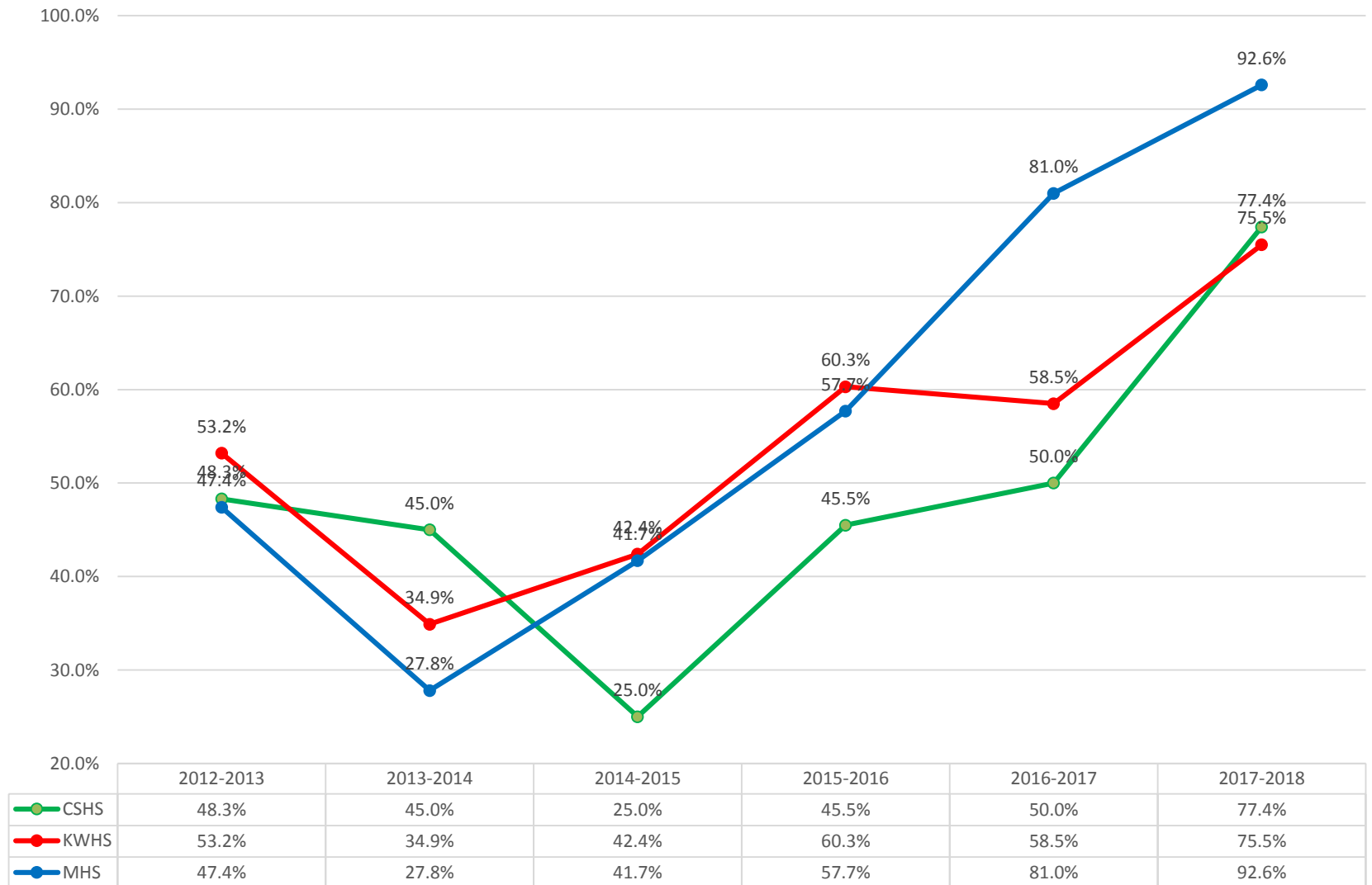
District Graduation Rates by At-Risk

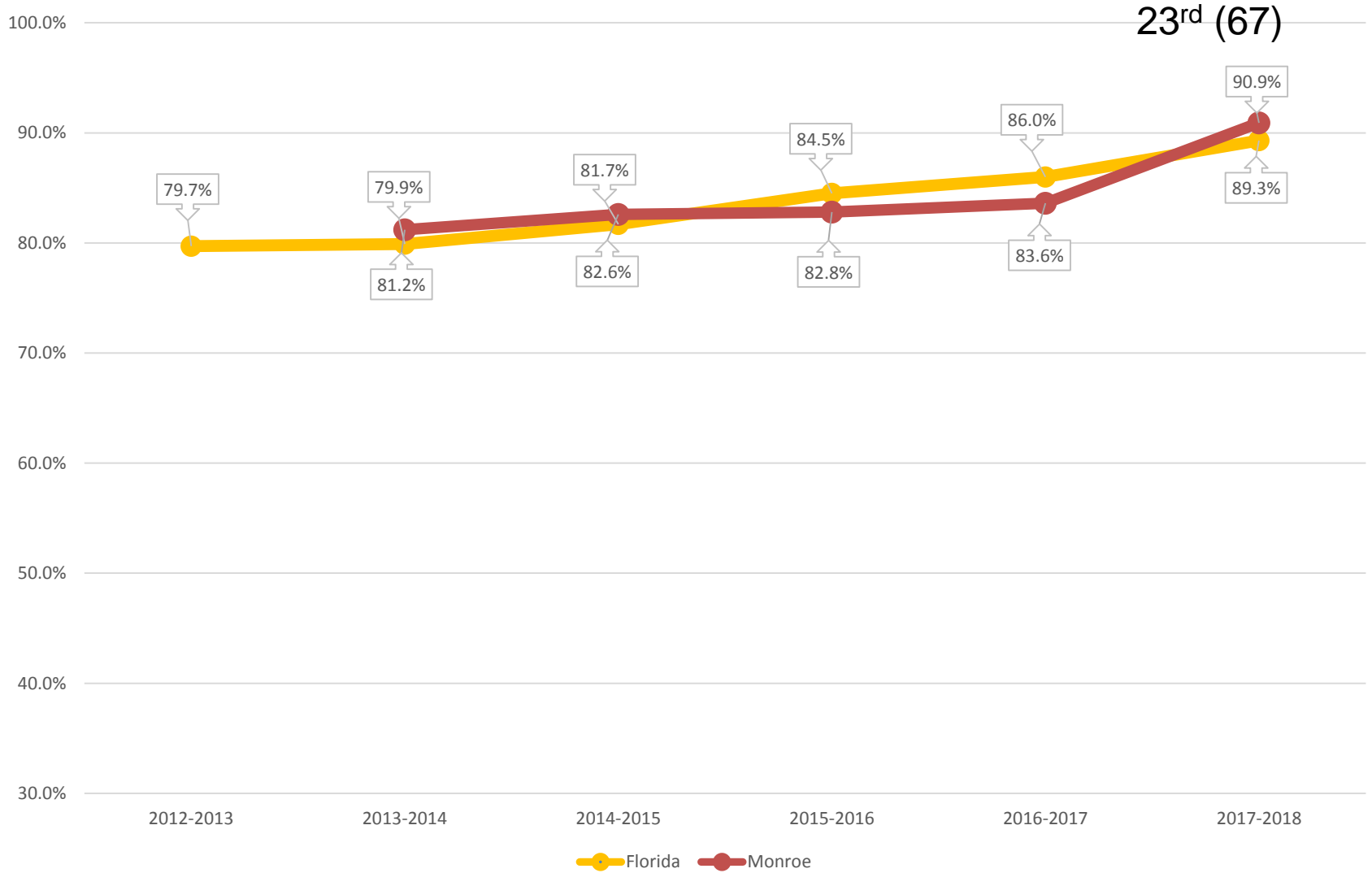


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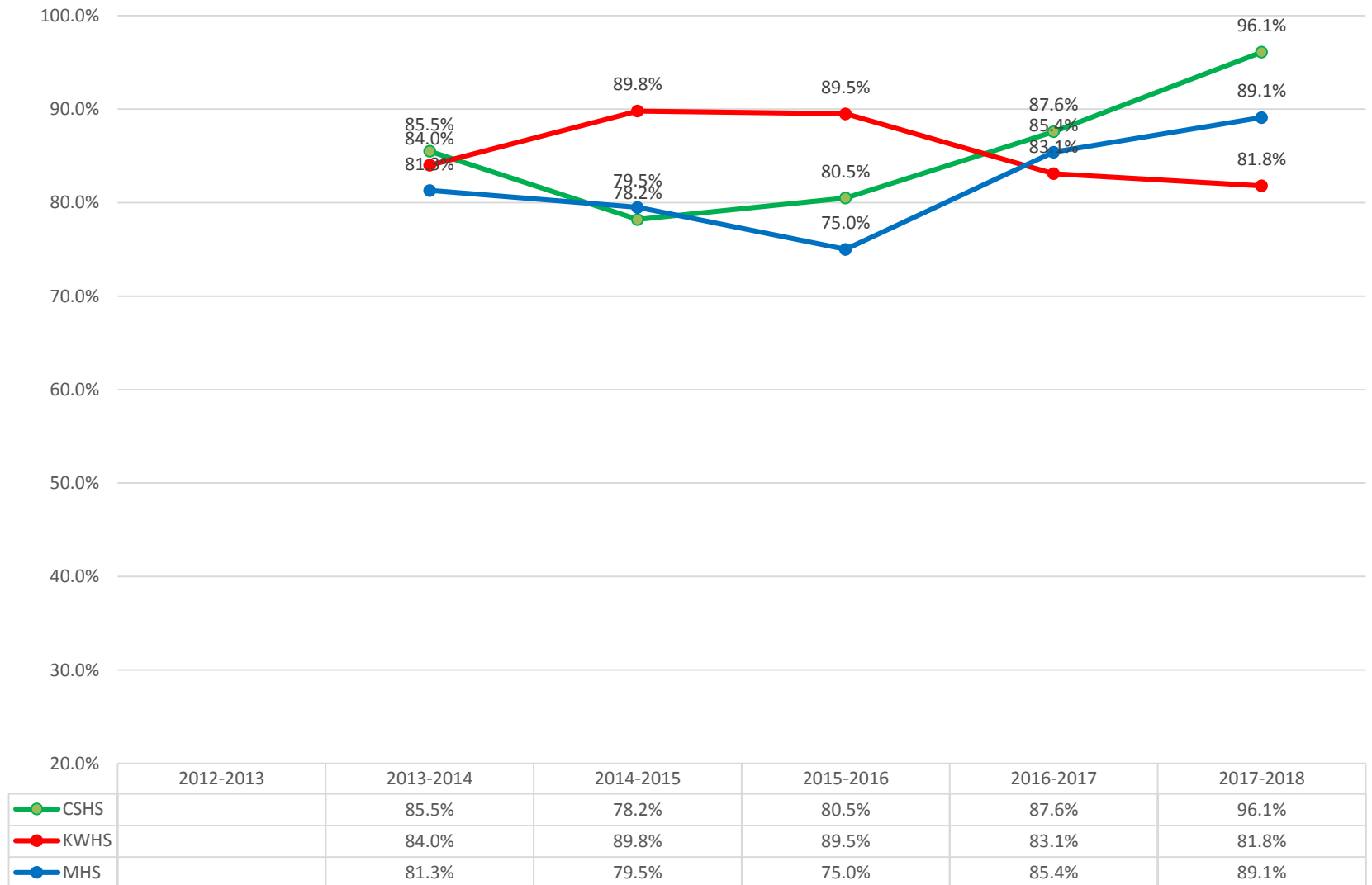
At Risk Students Graduation Rate



Female Students Graduation Rate

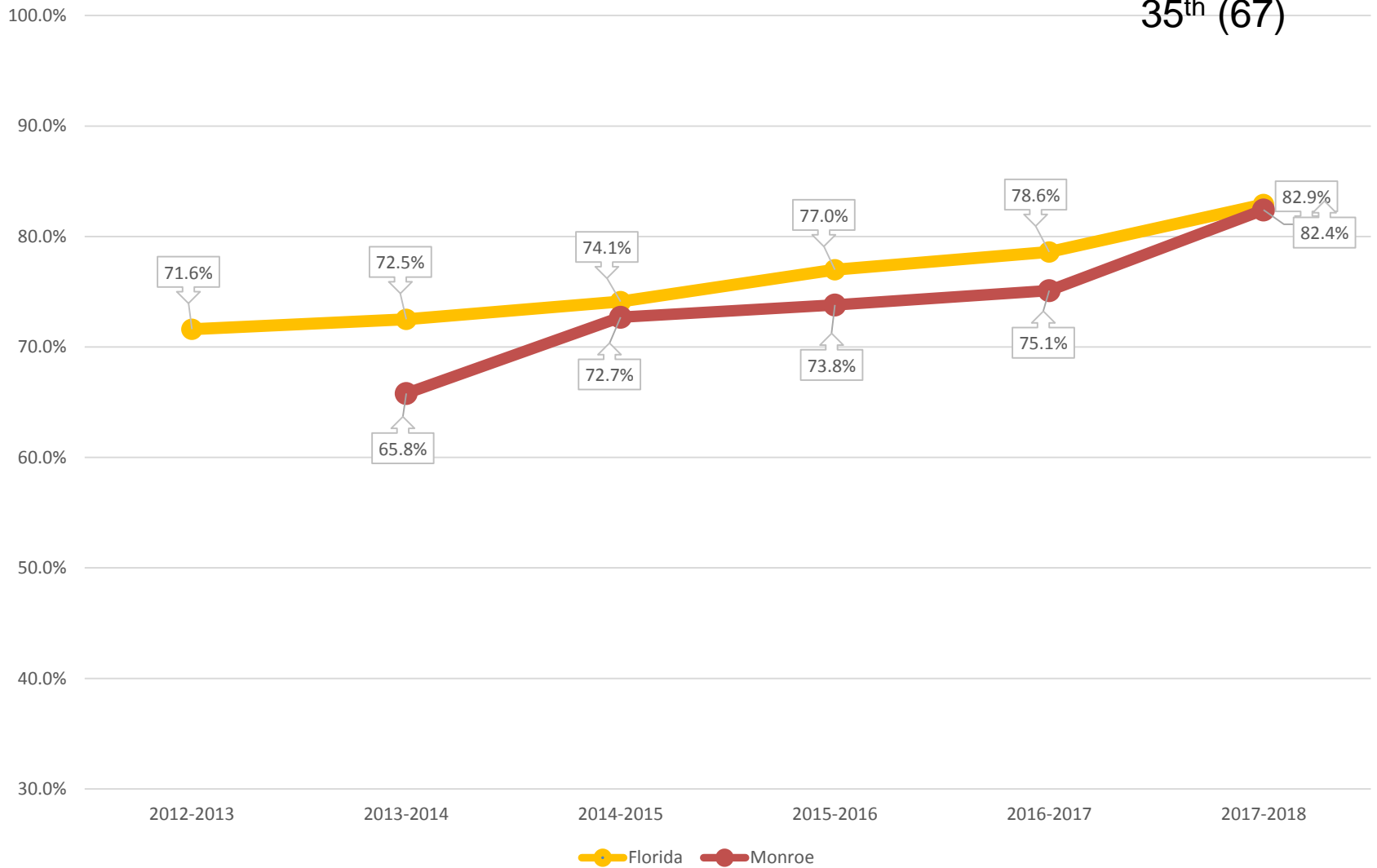


Female Students Graduation Rate

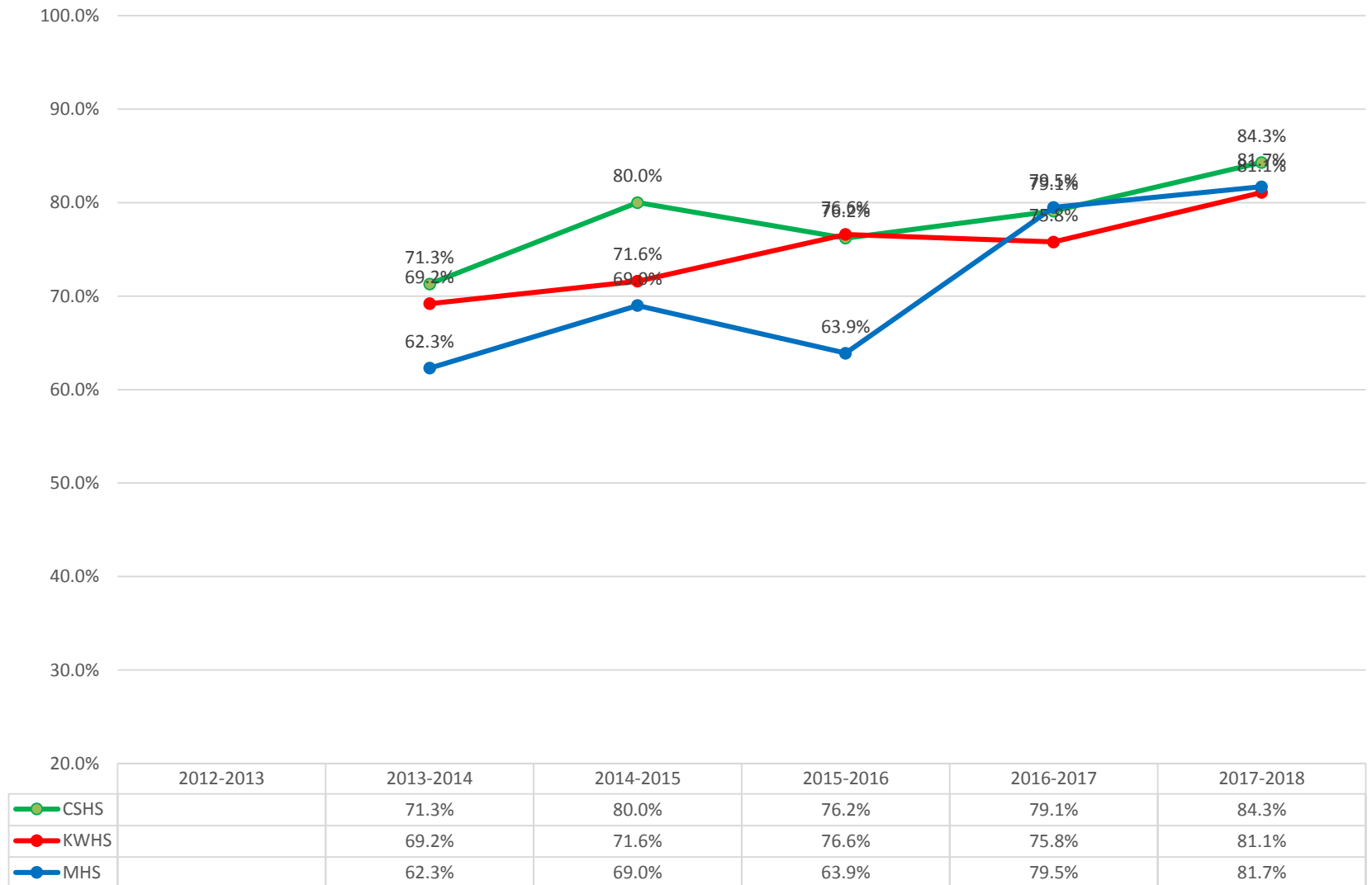


Male Students Graduation Rate
