





2019-2020 Adoption Schedule

Purchase of New Course Materials and Increased Enrollment only via CAPE funding

- Complete adoption process and select materials in 2019-2020
- Purchase/Implement in 2022-2023
 Funds must be spent within 3 years of adoption

2019-2020 IM budget will also complete the funding of 2017-2018 purchase of Civics Materials and 2018-2019 Science Materials on a five-year purchase.
