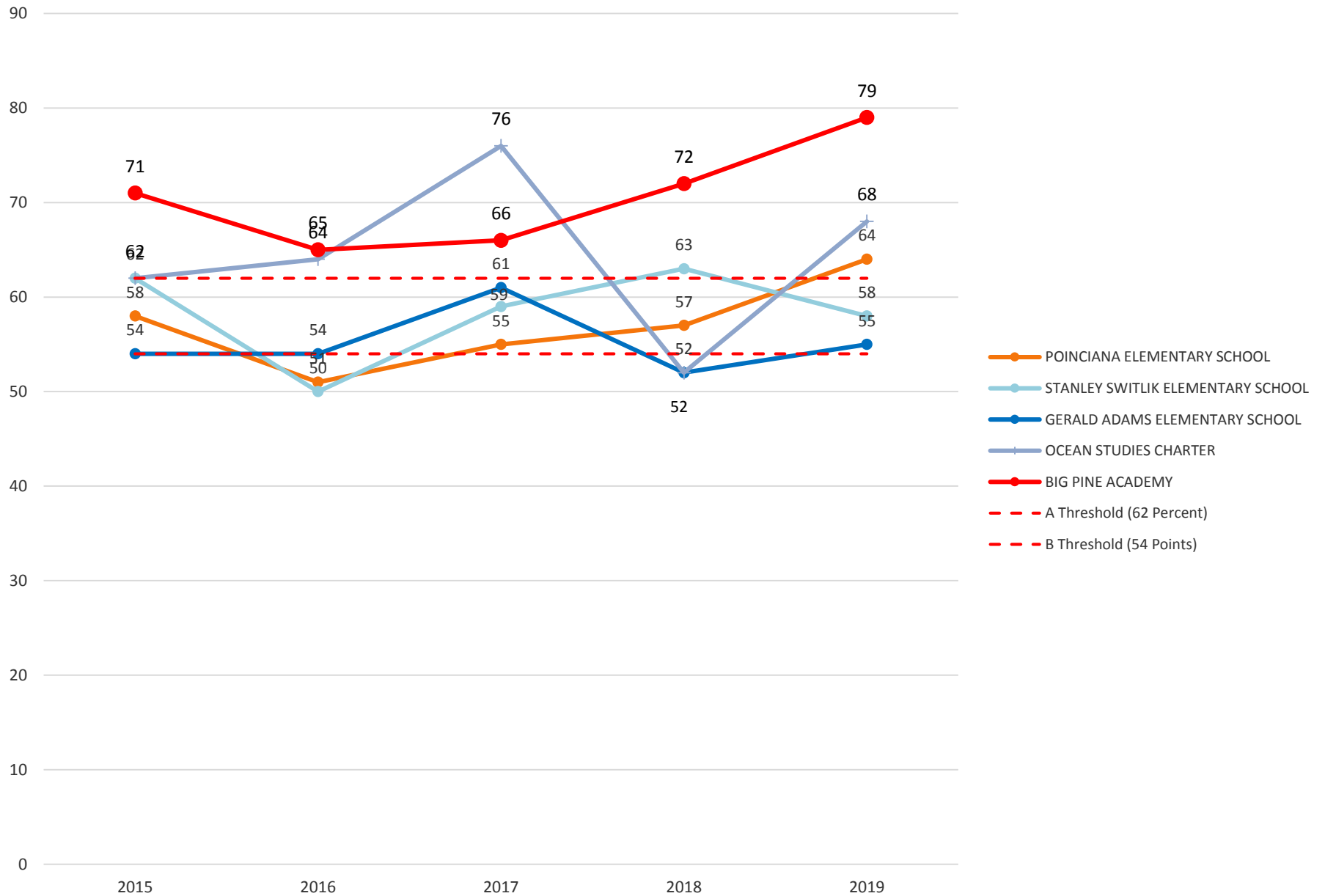

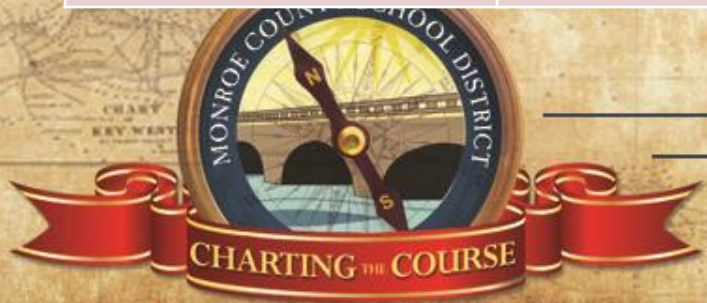

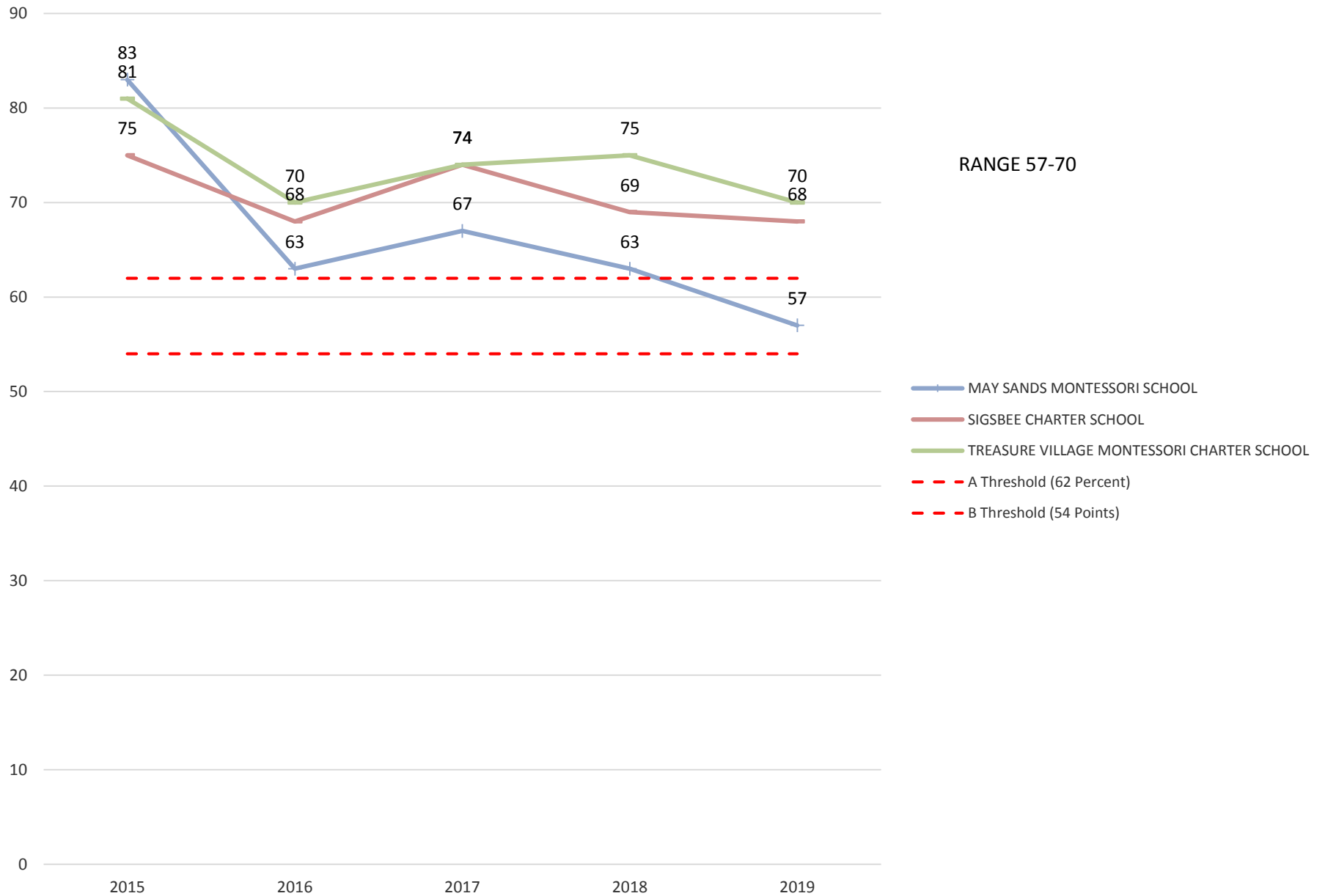


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K-8 Percentage of Total Points

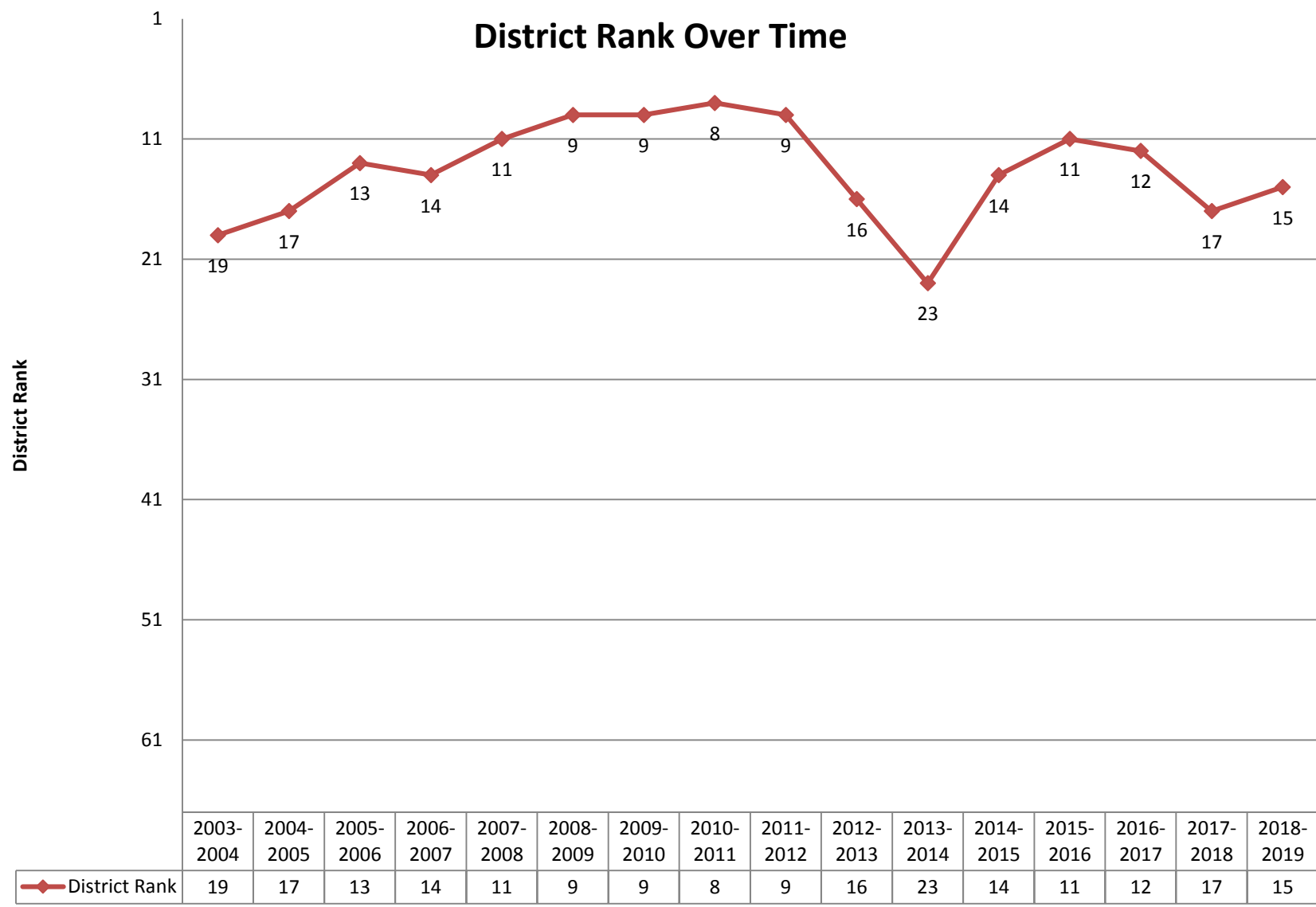

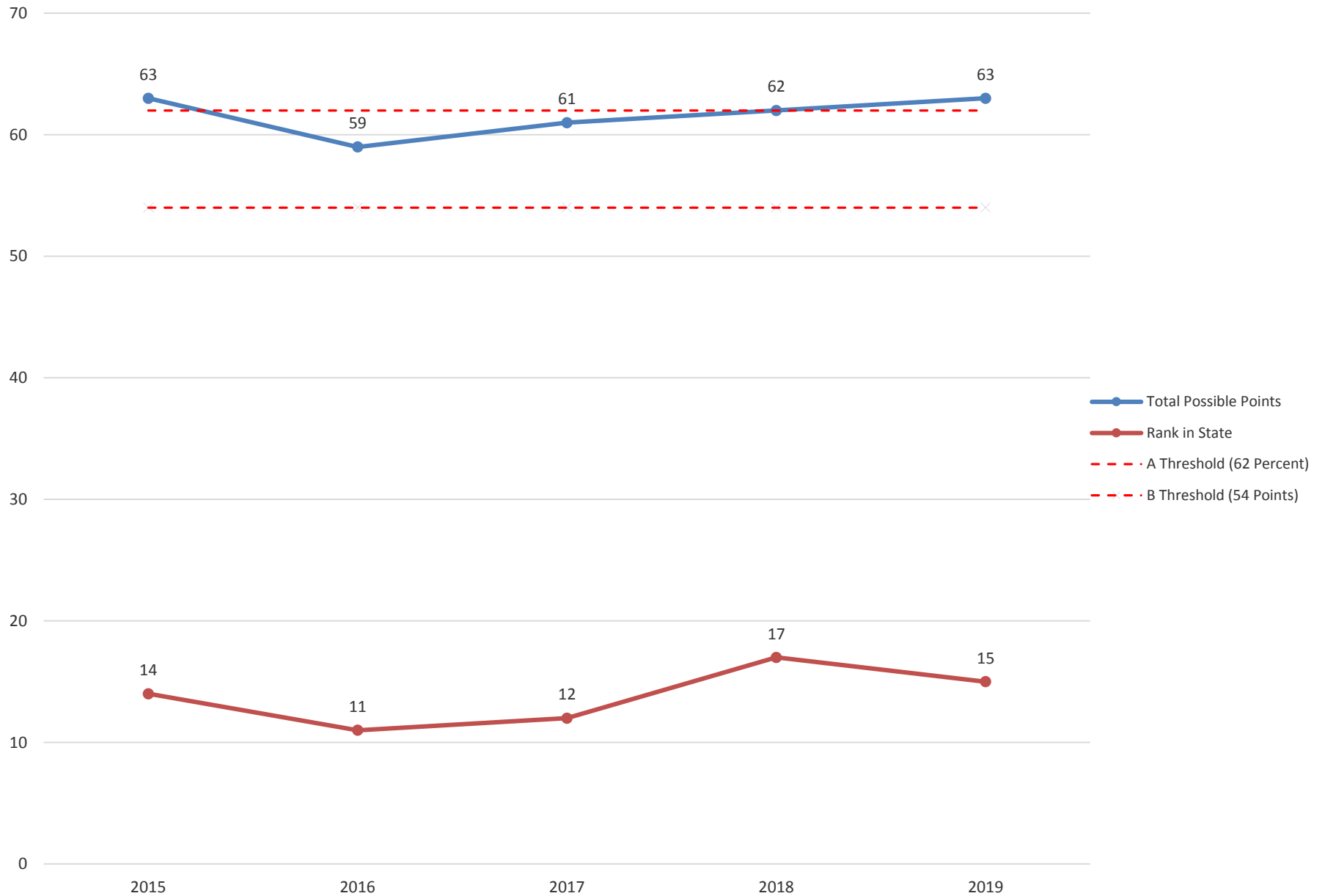

- 27% level 1 (lowest since 2013)

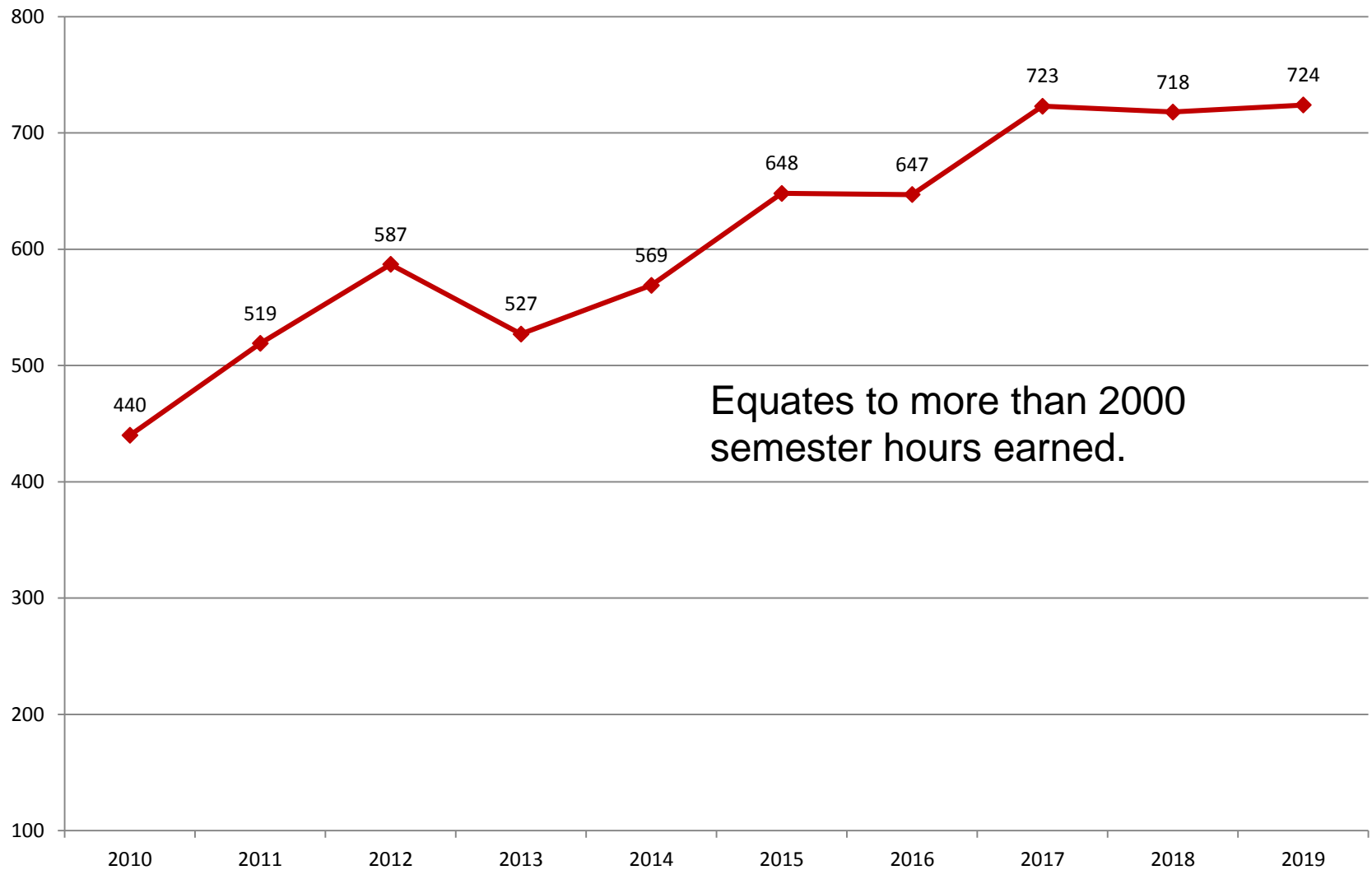


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AP Students by District
