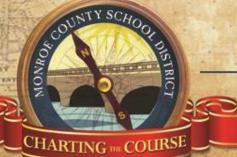

Public Meetings and Budget Adoption

- Approval of newspaper advertisement for Budget -July 23, 2019
- Advertisement placed in newspaper July 26,2019
- Public hearing on tentative budget July 30, 2019
- TRIM notices mailed to taxpayers
- Workshops on budget August 13
 - Public hearing on final budget September 10, 2019



Tax Increase/Rolled Back Rate

- Millage Levy
 - 2019/20 3.3430
 - 2017/18 <u>3.3580</u>
 Decrease in Millage <u>0.0150</u>
 - 6.87% Increase in the Property Tax Roll.

The "rolled-back rate" is the rate that would have provided the same ad valorem tax revenue that was levied the prior year without new construction.
