## Greater Community

#### Weekly Multi-Agency Meeting

- Food, medical and prescriptions support readily available for seniors citizens
- FKOC is limiting in-takes due to social distancing requirements and space available in their facilities
- Shelters are at or almost to capacity
- Legal Aid is helping with re-employment benefits and the paycheck protection program
  - · Appeals for those denied
- Food pantries county wide are strained, exceeding post Irma needs



- FKOC ran out of first round of funds and is on second - \$250/mo housing support
- United Way ran out of funds in first two weeks
- Still funds for rental assistance, prescriptions and food...but limited and expected to run out
- At least 50% of workforce is unemployed right now
- GCC and WH reporting significant increase in mental health struggles and substance use

- Chrome book distribution and internet supports
- Bi-Weekly Temperature Checks (student input)
  - Food, sleep, mental well-being, home needs
  - Teacher, para, school counselor, school social worker, or admin respond to need
- Weekly Audit (teacher input)
  - Teacher, para, school counselor, school social worker, oradmin respond to need
- Daily SEL's
  - All grade levels K-12




