Mrs. Axford,

Section 1012.07, Florida Statutes, requires the State Board of Education to annual identify areas of critical teacher shortage areas based on the recommendations of the Commissioner of Education. Florida Statutes and School Board Policy require the Superintendent to recommend specific projected public school teacher shortage areas for the next academic year to the School Board for approval. This recommendation identifies with certification areas facing an unmet need of certified teachers using current data on teacher supply and demand as provided by the State Department of Education.

Additionally, and as per the collective bargaining agreement, "Critical needs exceptions for higher placement on the schedule shall be reviewed and agreed upon annually by the Superintendent and UTM President." The Union and District are in agreement with this requirement.

For your recommendation to the Board, the following positions are presented for inclusion on the District's list of critical teacher shortage areas:
