5724 - PREPARATION FOR VOTER REGISTRATION

The School Board believes that preparing students to assume the responsibilities which our democratic society places on each of its citizens is an important function of the schools. Supplying our high school students with all pertinent information regarding voter registration is one crucial means of meeting this goal.

Accordingly, the Superintendent, using such resources as the high school administration, faculty and student body, local officials, and others can provide, shall develop a nonpartisan, voter education/registration program for allthe high schools in the District.

Additionally, each high school in the District The administration of the high schools shall offer the opportunity for enrolled students to all students who reach the age of majority, the opportunity to register as voters. In addition, the character development curriculum for grades 11 and 12 shall include instruction on voting using the uniform primary and general election ballot described in s. 101.151(9).

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
