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- District's capital planning process:
 - Maintenance and IT staff prepares proposed budget for the next five years. Transportation staff provides resource requirements for the next year's budget.
 - Finance staff assigns funding to requested projects based on available revenues.

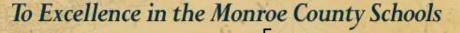


- In addition to the budgets requested on the previous slide, the District primarily budgets large projects (construction) on two bases:
 - Pay as you go
 - Debt Issuance

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Types and Amounts of Outstanding Debt

- Sales Tax Revenue Bonds (STRB)
 - \$61.27 Million, Matures October 1, 2025
- Certificates of Participation (COP)
 - \$69.47 Million
 - QSCB 36 Million, Matures June 2027
 - Series 2018A COP 31 Million, Matures June 2036



Debt Payments

- 2021 COPS Payment Require Payments from Half-Cent Sales Tax of \$3.1M for Four Years
 Total Debt Payments from Half-Cent Sales Tax \$16M
- Total Budgeted Revenue from Half-Cent Sales Tax \$19M
